Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:


At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the seventh day of October, A. D. 1876, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of ~~Brady~~ Brady, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from the South East Corner of lands of Henry Bantz to the Public Road leading from J. A. Copes to J. F. Rishell in said Township.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Geo. Kirk M. H. or S. H. Luther & John Potter

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

We the undersigned, appointed by the annexed or-
der do report; That in pursuance thereof, after
having been duly sworn according to law, viewed
the ground proposed for the within mentioned
road, and we do agree that there is occasion for
a road as desired by the petitioner. And we have
laid out and do return for private use the
following described road to wit: Beginning
at a stone at South-east Corner of lands of
Henry Bantz; Thence South, five perches to a
post at Township road leading from J. A. Terpil
to J. F. Reishels. We undersigned further report
that there are no damages resulting to any one
from opening the same. We further report, that
before the said view, public notice of the time and
place of the meeting of the viewers was given by
advertisements put up at three of the most public pla-
ces in the vicinity - ten days before said meeting.
We annex a plot or draft of said road laid out, sta-
ting the courses and distances, and noticing
briefly the improvements through which the same
passes.
