To the Hon Judges within named.

We, the undersigned persons appointed by the within Order of Court, to view, and lay out the Road therein mentioned, Respectfully Report. That having given notice of the time and place of meeting - And being all present, at the view of the ground proposed for the said road, and being all sworn or affirmed in pursuance of the said Order, we have viewed, and laid out, and do return the following Road viz, Beginning at the X Roads near J. R. H. Shook's House, and running through land of the said Shook North Sixty Eight and half degrees East, at (Sixteen perches crossing the line of Shook into land of Rebecca Joger) Fifty three perches to a stump, Thence through land of Joger and John Cunningham North Eighty Eight degrees East, thirty perches, South seventy seven and a half degrees East, twenty six perches, North seventy degrees East, eight perches, South seventy one and a half degrees East, twenty one perches to the line of John Cunningham and Samuel McLaughlin, Thence on their line North Eighty two degrees East at 86 perches B. or. Cor of Cunningham and Jacob Linefelt, Eighty nine perches, North Sixty six degrees East, sixteen and four tenths perches, South Sixty four degrees East, eight perches to line of Mr. Laughlin, Thence North Eighty two degrees East, (on line of Mr. Laughlin and Linefelt) Ten and four tenths perches to their Hickory Corner, Thence through land of James Curry South Sixty Eight East, twenty nine perches, North Eighty five degrees East, twenty eight perches, South seventy six degrees East, eight and five tenths perches, South Sixty two degrees East, seven and seven tenths perches, South fifty one and a half degrees East, twenty five perches, to a Pin, Thence South fifty eight degrees East, seven and three tenths perches, to a Pin, Thence South seventy eight degrees East, thirty two and five tenths perches, North Eighty seven East, eight perches, North seventy three degrees East, twenty four perches, North Eighty nine degrees East, six and seven tenths perches, North Eighty North Eighty three degrees East, twenty three and five tenths perches, South twenty five degrees East, twenty and five tenths perches to the line of E. D. Green and Enns, Mc Masters, Thence Between them North fifty degrees East, twenty six perches to the Public Road, near Enns Mc Masters, (which said Road as aforesaid laid out, we are of opinion is necessary for a Public Road And we are also of opinion that the County should pay to Rebecca Joger The sum of Twenty (\$20) Dollars, damage - she having but a small lot of ground and the above described road cutting it in two.

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 12 day of January, A. D. 1875, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Chest, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from the road leading past

J. R. K. Shooks and strikes the line between Solomon
Loziers and J. R. K. Shooks above Shooks Coat
bank and follows John Penningtons on past
his house and from the McGarvey Road near
Enos M Masters

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same; according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

S. I. McCloskey Gilbert Lozer & Jos. H. Bereth

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
