Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the Ninth day of Oct 1875, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Roady, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the vacation of a road or highway leading from Rumbarger to Evergreen

part of which the part proposed for said vacation is that which lies between a point at or near the Residence of A. J. Johnson and a point at or near a point at South East Corner of Lands of W. Bell on said Road,

Vacate and Supply

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Geo. C. Kirk M. H. Luther and John Nolder

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for vacation; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

To the Honorable, the Judges within named: We the undersigned, appointed by the annexed order do report, That

After having been severally sworn according to the ground proposed for the within men agree that there is occasion for a road, as and that the same is necessary for a public respect to the shortest distance and the best we have laid out and do return for public use the following described road to wit: Beginning at a post at Grant Street, near the residence of J. A. Johnson, in Rumbarger, thence North Thirteen and a half degrees West, twenty two & eight tenths perches to a post, thence South Seventy six and a half degrees West, eight perches to a post in public road, near Southeast corner of W. A. Bell's land. We further report, that there are no damages resulting to any one from opening the same. We also report, that we have enquired and do vacate that part of the old public road which is supplied by the above, and which by reason of the laying out of the first mentioned road has become useless. We further report, that before the said view, public notice of the time and place of the meeting of the viewers was given by advertisements put up at three of the most public places in the vicinity - ten days before said meeting. We annex a plot or draft of each road laid out, stating the courses and distances, and noticing briefly the improvements through which the same passes, and also a description and draft of the part vacated.
