Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the *Eight* day of *October*, A. D. 187*6*, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of, ~~in said county~~ *Bradford*, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from *Clearfield to Shreys by vacating from line of Jas. H. Grahams to John H. Stewart by a road intersecting these points by running a through line*

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

John L. Cottle *George Albert* & *Rudolph* ~~*Stacy*~~ *Buck*

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the County of Clearfield
The undersigned viewers appointed, in and by virtue of the Order of Court hereto annexed, Respectfully Report:

That they gave due timely and legal notice of the time and place of the meeting of the viewers by advertisements duly posted in public places in the township of Bradford, and having met upon the ground proposed for said road, proceeded to lay out and now return for Public use the following road. Beginning at the line of land of John H. Stewart thence on line of lands of Samuel Wilson & Vincent B. Holt, North eighty four perches - to intersection of old road - which is made and in use by the Public, and we believe said road to be necessary. And we return the old road by the following courses and distances for vacation Beginning at the intersection of old road. Thence South seven and one quarter degrees East Fifty (54) perches. South fifteen and one half degrees East fourteen perches. South six and one half degrees East nine & six tenths perches, and South fifty and one half degrees west fourteen perches to south end of the new road and beginning, which we believe and return as being necessary and convenient to the Township and ought to be vacated. The viewers were all sworn to perform their duty with impartiality and fidelity. A plot or draft is hereto annexed. All which is respectfully submitted.
