To the Hon the Judges of the Court of Sessions
now holding in & for Cleared County March Term
1876

Your Petitioner humbly sheweth that a certain
Road in Lawrence Township leading from a Public
Road from W. Hyman St to Public Road at Goodfellow
Bridge was confirmed ^{by the Sessions} Absolutely; that at the
Same Court a Public Road leading from same
Public Road at or near Bates Barn to same
Point at Goodfellow's Bridge was confirmed
Absolutely and saying from Your Court to set aside
the confirmation of the first mentioned Road
or both for the following reasons Viz
1st when the first mentioned Road came up for
hearing it was continued to March Term and by some
mistake it was confirmed without our knowledge or a
change of place heard
2^d Besides a great unnecessary Public Expense it
is a grievous nuisance to J. M. Peters, brother
doing a great injury to his Property containing
only 56 acres with those two the River Road
and Rail Road crossing the same and I believe
a man could stand above the upper one & throw
a stone over these three roads & the Rail Road
causing the fencing of these three roads
the 1st mentioned Road running diagonally through it
3^d There is no necessity for the three roads as there
requiring the 1st mentioned Road to escape
the crossings on the Rail Road can come
to the Road from the Point at Mills but
those on the River could not go up to the 1st Road

The Viewers appointed were interested
 themselves, and all near relatives to nearly
 all the Petitioners for Laid Road all of
 which can be Proven to the Satisfaction
 of your Honorable Court; The Viewers might
 have made such Report had they not been,
 but the action do not look right
 And we ask your Hon Court to set aside Laid's
 Confirmation and Grant a Review if
 you think such Road necessary or give us a
 chance to be heard if they will ever play
 fair. Or Rule to show cause why Confirmation should not be set aside.
