Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the *Ninth* day of *October*, A. D. 187*5*, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of, ~~in said county~~ *Covington*, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from *Mignot School House*

on the Clearfield & Harthaus Road to Central point - to vacate & supply that portion lying between said Mignot School house and the line of Lewis Ricard in Covington Twp

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view ^{*vacate*} and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Charles Schnarrs L Flood & John Mulson

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; ^{*& vacate*} and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

appointed by the within order of Court, to
view, and lay out, the road therein mentioned, all being
Present, and first, severally sworn according to Law,
do report, that in pursuance of said order, we
have viewed and laid out, and vacated,
Beginning at the Migrant School House, thence
South 63 rods to stone, thence south
75 rods, 18 rods, to the supply road, ^{in this part, vacated} in all 66
rods, on the boundary line of J. Puskey, and
L. Beard, thence North, on the supply road,
35 rods, to the Township road, leading to
Deer creek, the supply road being 31 rods
less, of Township road, and on good ground,
and do Report, for Publick road,

and provided; and they will ever pray &c.
