Exceptions to Report of viewers in No. 1 Dec. Sessions 1883

First. — That the petition does not state the township in which the road prayed for is proposed to be laid out.

Second. — That the road returned by the viewers was not measured by them nor were measurements made, and the courses and distances ascertained, in their presence.

Third. — That the distance between the termini is not correctly stated in the report; and that a road beginning "at a point in the public road leading from Ansonville to Marrou at or near Green Run Bridge" and running the several courses and distances as stated in the report will fall far short of the terminus designated in the petition and order as "a point in public road leading from Ansonville to Lumber City, at the land of R. M. Johnson, 400 feet from Little Clearfield Creek Bridge" and will not reach the road leading from Ansonville to Lumber City at any point whatever.

Fourth. — That the road as shown on the draft annexed to the report is not the road as prayed for in the petition and does not conform to the order to view, the petition and order being for a road ending at "a point in public road leading from Ansonville to Lumber City, 400 feet from Little Clearfield Creek Bridge" while the terminus of the road shown on the draft is not 400 ft from Little Clearfield Creek Bridge either by a direct line or by the road leading from Ansonville to Lumber City.

Fifth — That the time of the view is not stated
in the report.

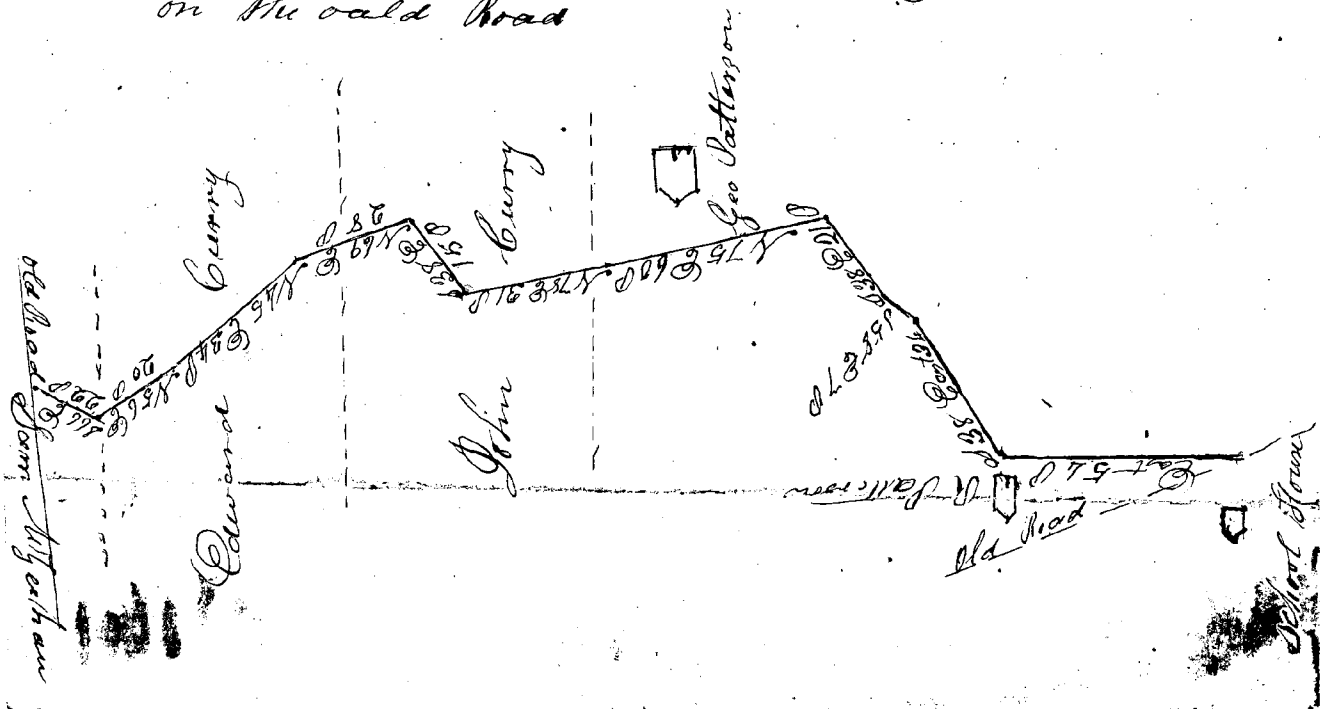

We the undersigned appointed in the foregoing order as reviewers having given due notice according to law by written advertisements of the time and place of meeting and having been first severally duly sworn or affirmed, did thereupon on the 9th day of October 1875 proceed to review the road mentioned in the said order as therein directed; all of us being present upon the ground, and having reviewed the same we have laid out and returned as necessary for public use the following road to wit beginning at the Pattersons School House and thence East fifty four Perches thence South 38 degrees East 34 Perches thence South 58 degrees East 7 Perches thence South 38 degrees East 21 Perches thence North 75 degrees East 60 Perches thence North 78 degrees East 31 perches thence South 38 degrees East 15 Perches thence North 69 degrees East 28 Perches thence North 45 degrees East 34 Perches thence North 56 degrees East 20 Perches thence South 66 degrees East 22 Perches to Samuel W. Leeshaw Farm on the old Road



Which road so as aforesaid laid out we are of opinion is necessary for a Public road and that the old road so far it is thereby supplied be abandoned and vacated from the School House at Pattersons to the line of John Currys Farm

We further report that the said road as laid out by us passes through the Farms of Robt & Geo Patterson also through John & Edward Currys Farms and as the damages accruing or that may accrue to Edward Curry we assess them at twenty dollars, \$20.00

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in, and for said county, on the 19th day of March, A. D. 1875, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Jordon, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a ^{change in} road or highway, leading from Sam. M. Cheekans

to John Williams farm at or near Pattersons School House

Report as to damages

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

John M. Cord - J. Patterson & Ezra Young

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, ^{change of} ~~are to view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them~~ agree that there is occasion for such ^{change of} road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
