Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 4 day of October, A. D. 1875, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of, in said county ^{Morris}, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from Thos. Raylers et al Asking

Public road leading from Plum Road near a point known as Hockenberry to a point on the Christ lands known as the maple corner.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

John L. Cuttle George Hoover, & James Hughes.

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

The undersigned viewers duly appointed in and by virtue of the order of Court hereto annexed, to view and lay out a road to lead from the Plunk road near Hockenburg.

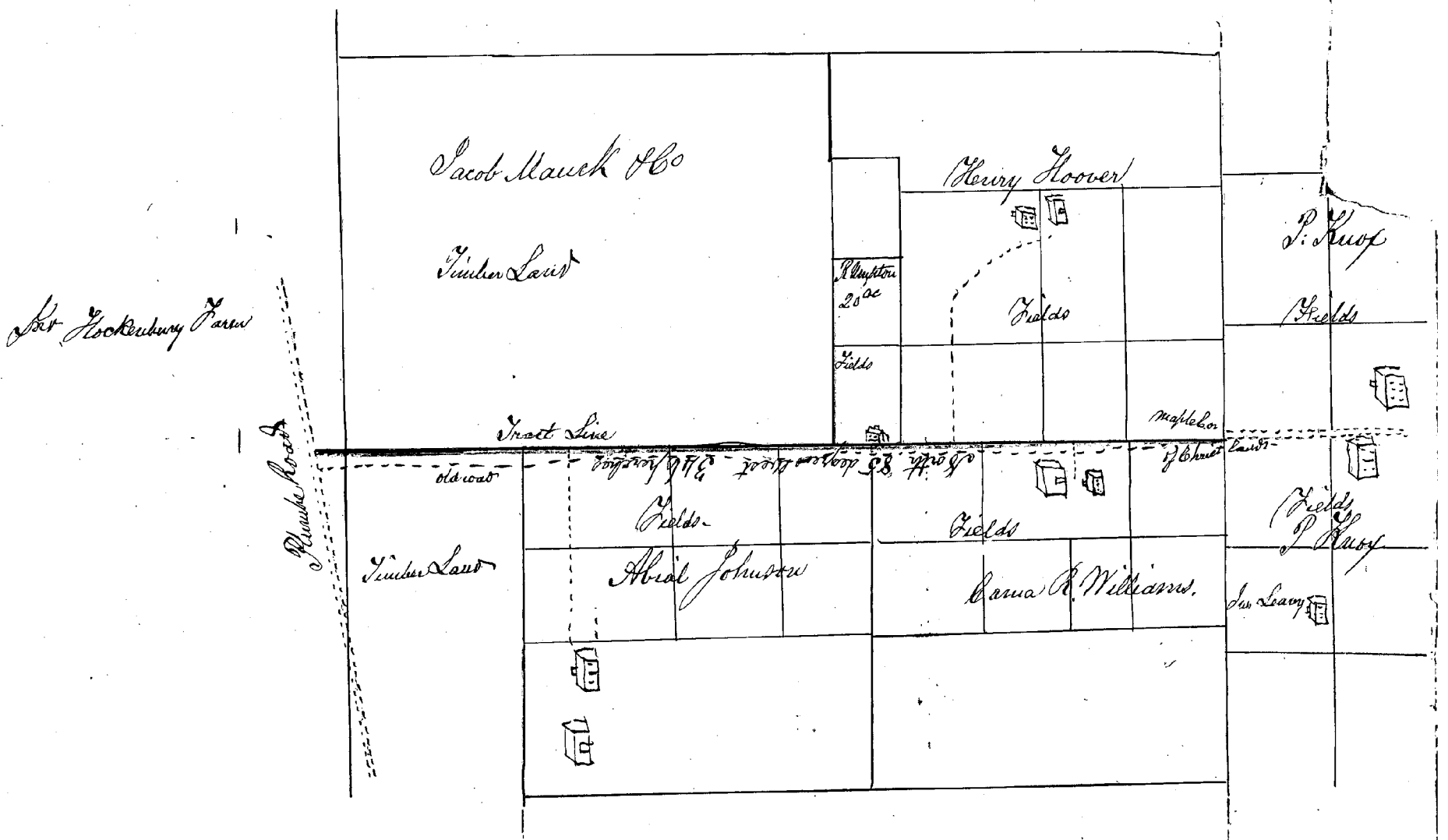
Respectfully Report.

That having given due timely and legal notice, by public advertisements duly posted in public places in the Township of Morris, in said county, of the time and place of the meeting of the viewers, for more than five days previous to making the view, that they all met upon the ground proposed for said road, and being first duly sworn or affirmed according to law, after examining the ground, proceeded to lay out the following road. Beginning at the Maple corner of tracts in name of David Beverage and Francis Johnson. thence by tract line North 85° West Three hundred and thirty six perches, & same course ten perches to "Plunk Road" at Hockenburg, in all Three Hundred and Forty six perches - which road we consider necessary, and do now return the same for Public Use. All which is respectfully Submitted
