Contents,

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court
of Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the
County of Clearfield,

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants
of the Township of Girard in the said County
respectfully sheweth.

That they are under a great expense on account
of the division line between Girard and Covington
Township in said County that said division was
made under the influence of Peter Lamm one
of the first settlers in order to have all his lands
in Girard Township. That in this respect there
is one settler whom has never been able to school
his childrens in said township, further that since
this line was made the road leading from the
mouth of Deer Creek in Girard township to the
Karthaus and Clearfield Road in Covington^{TP} has
been reviewed and altered four or five times at
the expenses of Girard township to the amount
of seven or eight hundred dollars for the benefit
of the Citizens of Covington township and further
that a new review has taken place here of late
on the same route if said review is granted
it will cost Girard township at least as much
as has been spent already and as stated before
for the benefit of Covington township.

Your petitioners therefore pray the Court to
appoint disinterested persons to examine the same

and have the line continued on the same direction from
Dominic Breaults place to the river a distance of about
three quarters of a mile abandoning the effect to the
benefit of Covington township.

Corner of No. 1939 and S.E. corner of No. 1936. thence through No. 3647 S. 4 W. 310 p. to the river above the mouth of Deer Creek cutting about two thirds of No 3647 off of Girard Township.

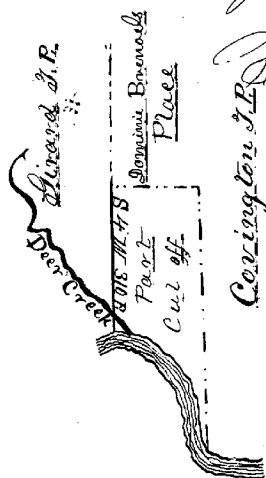

We the persons appointed by the above order of Court to view and change the Township line therein mentioned having viewed and made the above report on same and same having been referred back to us by an order on back of above order to review and report anew, we report as follows:— Beginning at Dominic Bruncks place being the S.E. corner of No. 1936 & S.W. corner of No. 1939 thence through No 3647 S. 4 W. 264 p. to Deer Creek thence down Deer Creek S. 51 E. 26 p. to the River thus making Deer Creek part of the line and leaving the small point that was cut off by the view above the mouth of Deer Creek remain in Girard Township in all the rest being of the same opinion as before report the same, for which see first report above.—
