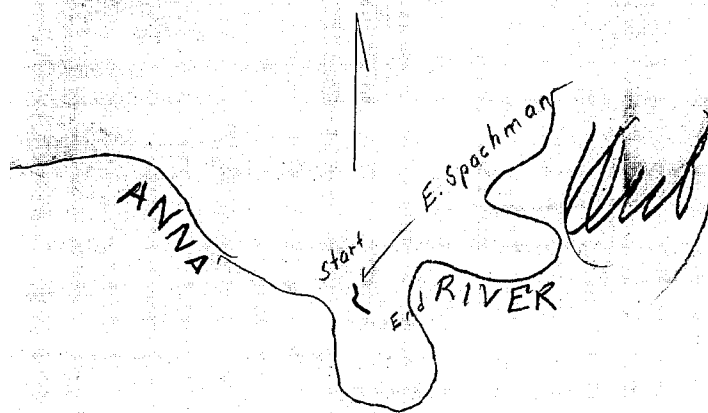

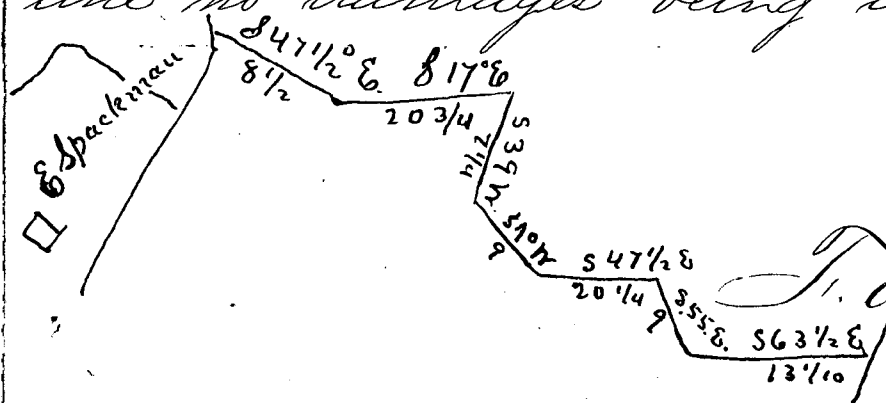
present to the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according
to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint
Benjamin Magist Henry Steele & Am Murray
to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them
agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed - to lay out the same, as agreeably to
the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the
shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make
report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same
necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft
thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improve-
ments through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter
Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state
that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

We the undersigned viewers appointed in and by virtue of the order of Court hereto annexed do report that having given due and timely notice of the time and place of meeting of the viewers by advertisements duly posted in public places for more than five days previous to making the view and being first duly sworn or affirmed went upon the grounds proposed for said road and examined the same and now return for private use said road according to the following courses and distances.
