To the Honorable the judges within named:

We the undersigned persons appointed by the within or annexed order of court, to view and lay out the road therein mentioned, respectfully report: That all of the viewers having been present at the view of the ground proposed for said road, and having all been first severally sworn or affirmed, and having given due and timely notice of said view, in pursuance of the said order, we have viewed, and laid out, and do return for public use the following road

By- Beginning at the north corner of Swoope Street and Lintonie Avenue in North Mountzdale; thence along Swoope Street S. 53° E. 870 feet to a stump; thence N. 71° 45' E. 212 feet to coal street in Higginaville; thence along coal street S. 86° 15' E. 570 feet to post; thence South 65° 10' E. 511 feet to post; thence along Beaver St in Higginaville to 40 West 1959 feet to a post; thence S. 20° W. 226 feet to a post in township Road 64 feet North of Moshannon Branch of Tyconne and Clearfield R. Road. Said road passes through improved lands of Mountz Pairs; Jessi Higgins and Beaver Coal Company. But that the owners will sustain

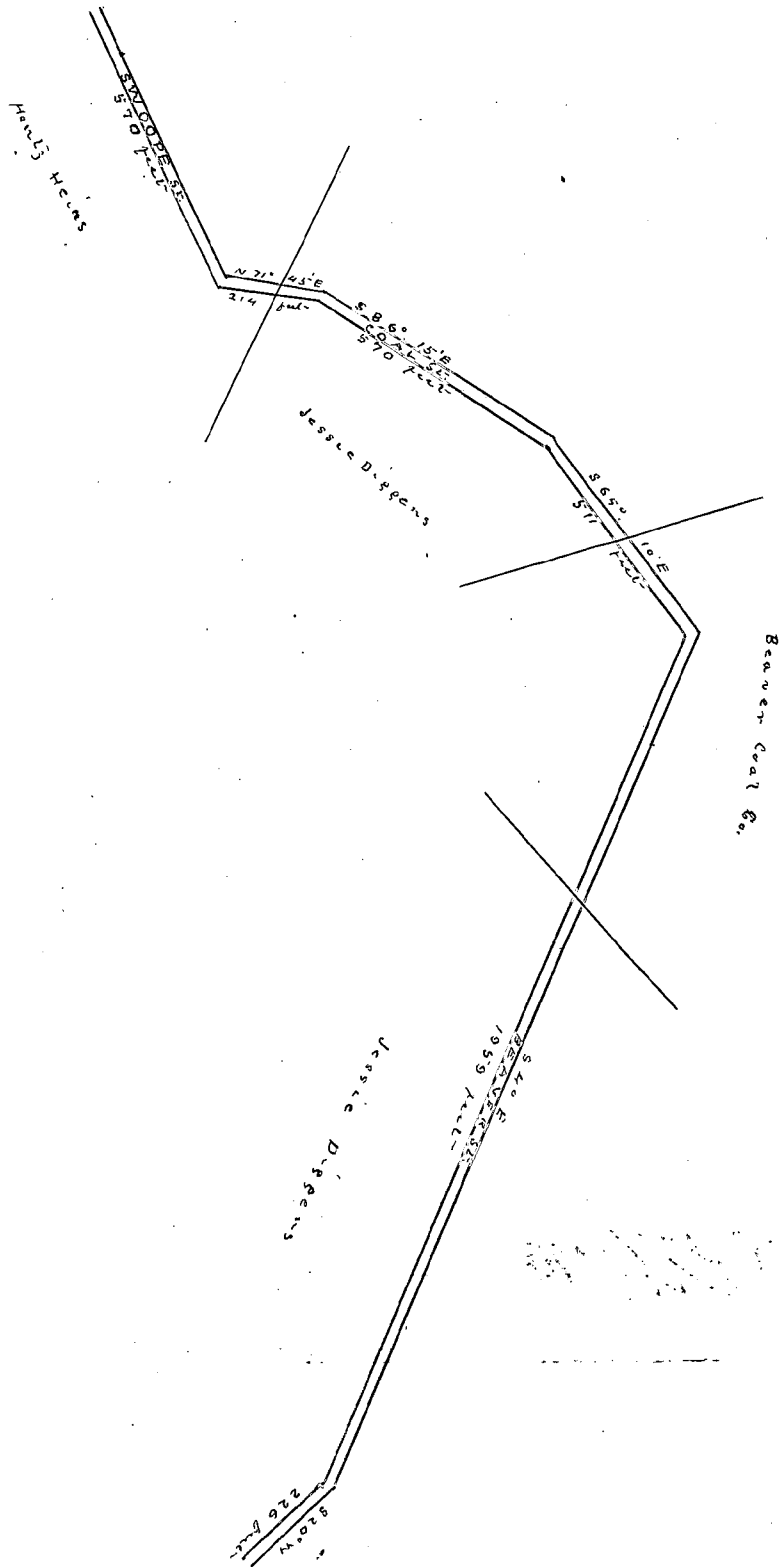
no damage, A plot or draft of said

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 14 day of Feb, A. D. 1876, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of, in said county Woodbury, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from a point on a Public Road near the Sterling Stables to a point on a public Road in the Village of North Houtsdale near Gleasons Store House

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Don St George Youizer, Jesse Higgins, and David Westover who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
