to the Indiana County line near James Martins that
a portion of the west end of said road has not yet
been opened and it appearing to your petitioners that
the part of said road from where it leaves the line between
Levi Sunderlins farm and Jacob W Campbells farm to
the County line if opened and made on the ground
on which it was originally laid out that it will be
very expensive and burthensome they therefore pray
the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay
out that part of said road above mentioned on
a route that will be less expensive ~~and~~ burthensome
to your petitioners and they will pray

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 10th day of January, A. D. 1876, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of, ~~in said county~~ Bell, ^{of a vacation & supplying}, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from Curwensville to Indiana which lies between Indiana County Line and Line of Levi Sunderlins and Jacob W Campbells farms

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Chas W Moore Robert Mahaffey & John W Bell who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

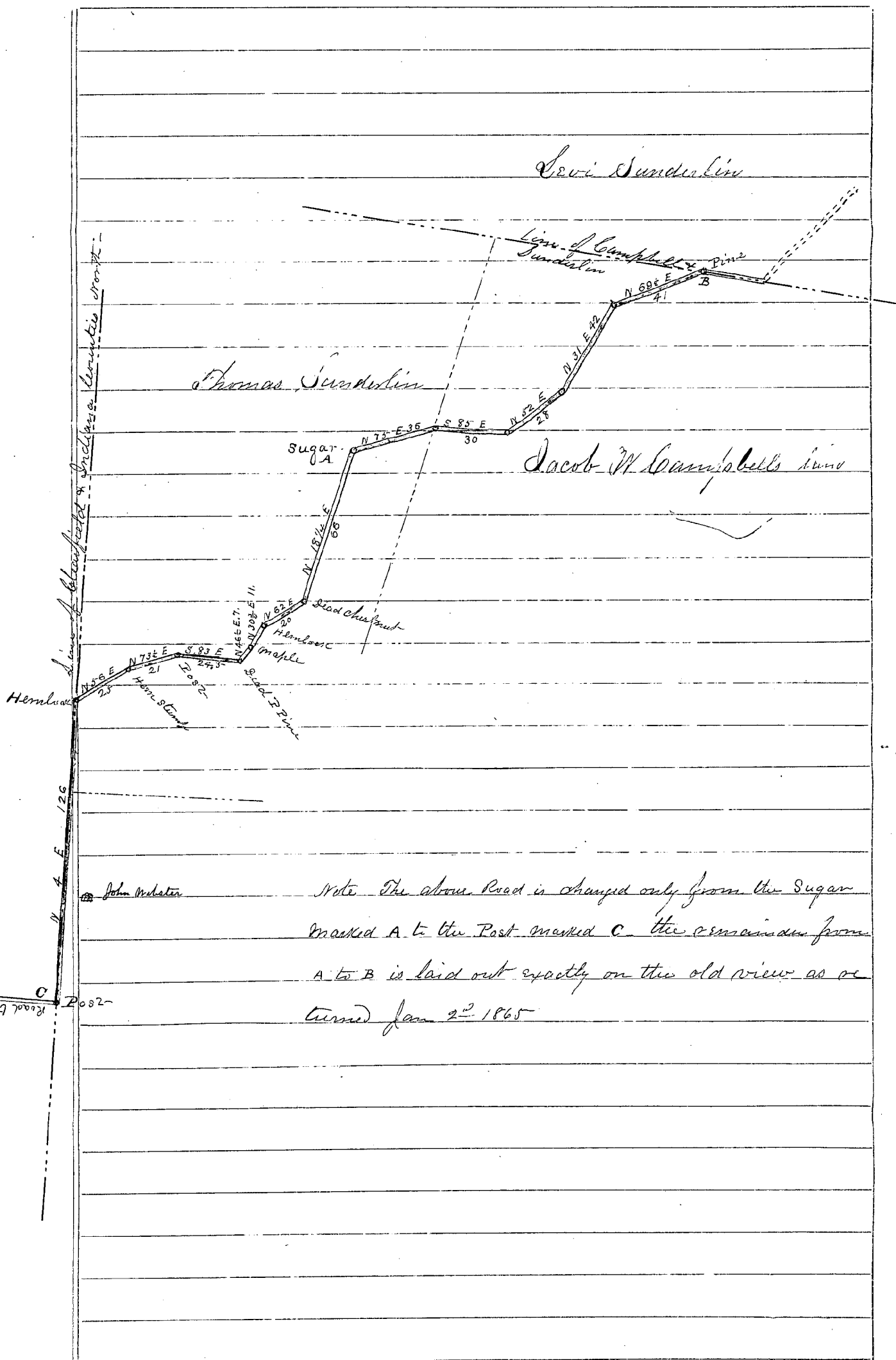

appointed by the foregoing order of Court to re-view
the road therein described ~~re~~ Report, that in pur-
suance of said appointment ~~after having first given~~
public notice of more than five days of the time
and place of said review by advertisements put up
according to Law, & having given notice to owners
& occupants of Lands on which said review & change
was to be made we all met, and after being duly
affirmed did proceed to review said road &
have changed it by the following courses & distances
Beginning at a Sugar. now gone on said road as
viewed & laid out on the 2^d of Jan. 1865. on land of
Thomas Sunderlin. Thence by a new line S $18\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W
66 perches to a Dead Chest on line of Thomas Sunderlin
and James B Sunderlin. thence S 62° W. 20. perches to a
Hemlock, thence S $32\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W. 11 perches to a maple - thence
S $46\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 7 perches to a Dead Pitch Pine. Thence N 83° W. $24\frac{1}{2}$
perches to a Post - S $73\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 21 perches to a Hem Stump
an angle on former view. Thence S 56° W. 25 perches to
a Hemlock on the line of Indiana & Clearfield Counties
thence by said County line South (Present magnetic Bearing S. 42° W.)
126 perches to intersection of a view of Road to Indiana
town - a plot or draft of which we hereto annex
and we having enquired as to damages resulting to any
one by reason of the passage of said road have ascertained
that no damage results to any one
