ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 22 day of March A. D. 1878, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of ^{Daniel L. Flynn and} ~~subscribers~~ ^{inhabitants} of the township of Gulick, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from the road leading the east end of Gulick Township ^{commonly} called the road through the Ginter Settlement to the Old Philipsburg Road through the lands of R. B. McCully or on the line between R. B. McCully & George Stanley Leatharine Wilson and Alex Ream and Mr Scott

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Henry B. Wright Ed Miller and Geo Stanley, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.

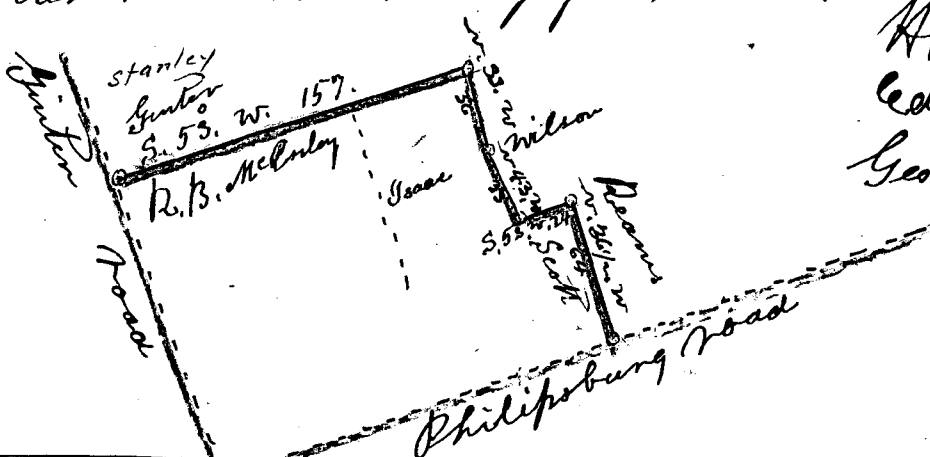

We the persons appointed by the within order of Court, to view and lay out the Road therein Mentioned, having first been sworn according to law, there being no damages, do report, that in pursuance of the said Order, we have viewed, laid out, and returned for private use, the following Road, to wit: Beginning on the Ginter road, and the line between D. B. McCulloch, and Geo Stanley thence South 53° West one hundred and fifty three perch, thence North 33° West through J. Wilsons land thirty six perch, thence through same land North 43° West thirty three perch, thence South 53° West along Wilsons and Scotts line twenty four perch, thence along Scotts and Beams line North 36° West sixty four perch to the Philipsburg road, a draft whereof is hereunto annexed. Witness our hands the 15th day of April 1878.

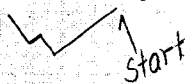
