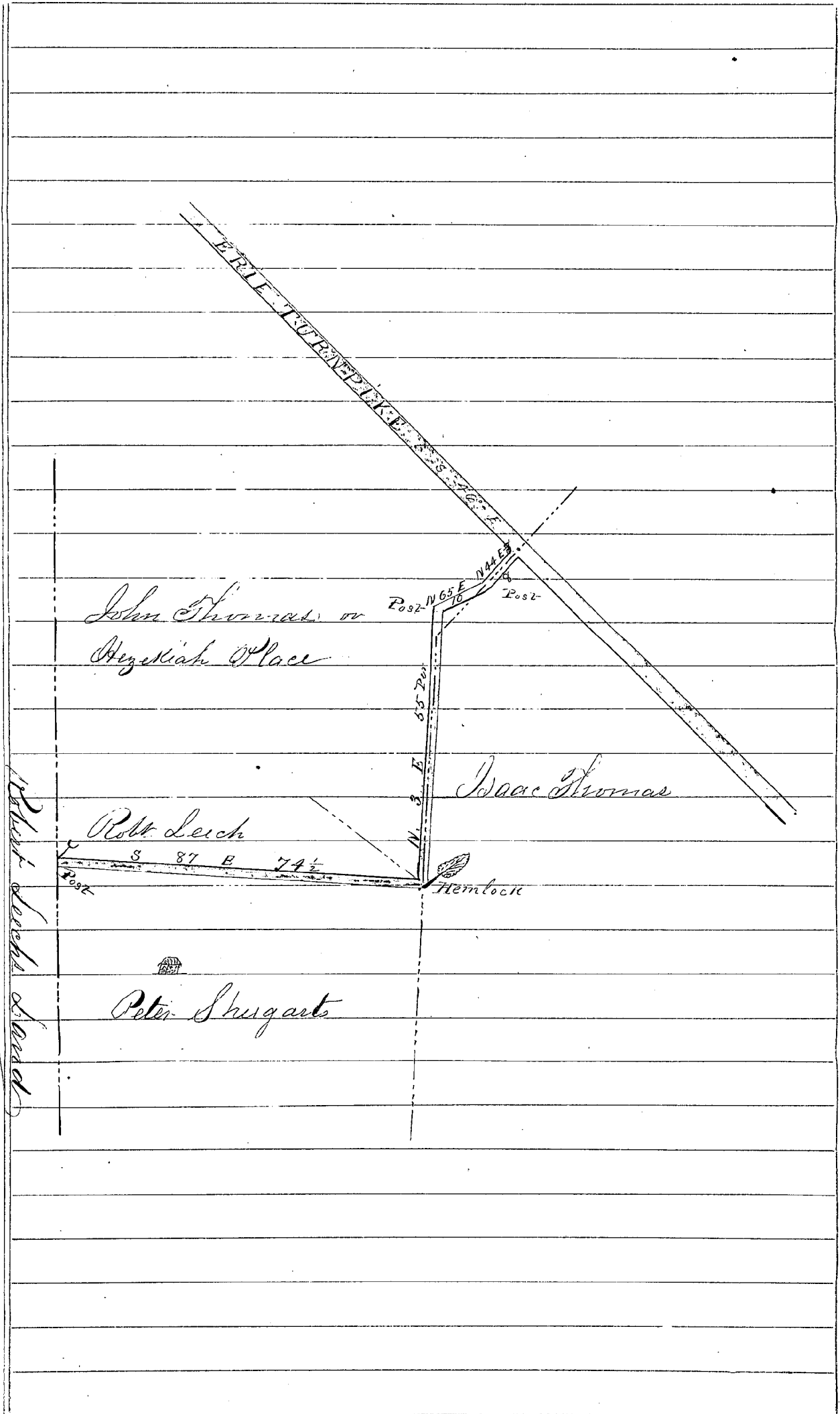

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 15th day of June, A. D. 1876, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of, ~~in said county~~ Bloom, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from the Erie Turnpike at or near residence of Isaac Thomas to land of Peter Shugart

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

J. W. Moore, C. A. Woods and Wm. Force

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

after having first given Notice by Advertisements put up
according to Law of the time and place of said View &
having given Notice to Owners & occupants of Land through
which said road was intended to pass of the same, we all
met and being duly Affirmed proceeded to view the ground
for said proposed road and have laid out and do return
for Public use the following road Viz Beginning at
a Post corner of Peter Shugart's Land & adjoining land of Robert
Leech. Thence by Shugart & Leech's line S. 87° E 74.5 perches to a
Hemlock corner of said Shugart & Leech & on line of Isaac Thomas
Thence by said Thomas' line & land of John Thomas alias Heg-
eriah Place N 3° E - 55 perches to a Post Thence through Land
of John Thomas alias Hegeriah Place N 65° E 10 perches to line
of Isaac Thomas & by same N 44° E 8 perches to the Erie
Turnpike a plot or Draft of which we herewith annex
and we having enquired as to Damages resulting to any one by
reason of the passage of said road have ascertained that no
damages results to any one
