Mr Foster & John M. Gaughan sold and jointly
conveyed unto the Commonwealth of Pa for the use
of Clearfield county in the sum of four thousand
Dollars Lawfull Money of the United States of America
to be paid to the said county apread their agents
Attorneys &c; to which Payment Mr bind ourselves
Our heirs Executors &c by these Presents
Sealed with our Seals and dated this 28th day of
January A.D. 1876

The Condition of this obligation
is Such That, Whereas by an act of the general
Assembly of Penn^a the undivided Road Taxes of certain
tracts of land in Pine Township Clearfield County (See act)
was to be appropriated to making keeping in repair
certain Roads viz from A. L. Ogden's Landing to Pinfis
& also to Rockton so far as is allowed (See act of
Assembly) And Whereas the Court of Sessions of
Clearfield county at the May Session of 1876 appointed
James L. Leary Commissioner & Superintendent
Manager & Repair^{the} Roads Now if the
Said James L. Leary shall well & duly attend
to the duties of his appointment And shall duly
Account for all monies that shall come
into his hands for that purpose viz Repairs
Expenses &c and shall furnish a written
Statement to the County Auditor at their
Session in 1877 And shall pay over
any Balance found in his hands to the
County Treasurer or other Person appointed
to receive the same Settlement then this
obligation to be void else to be &
remain in full force & virtue
