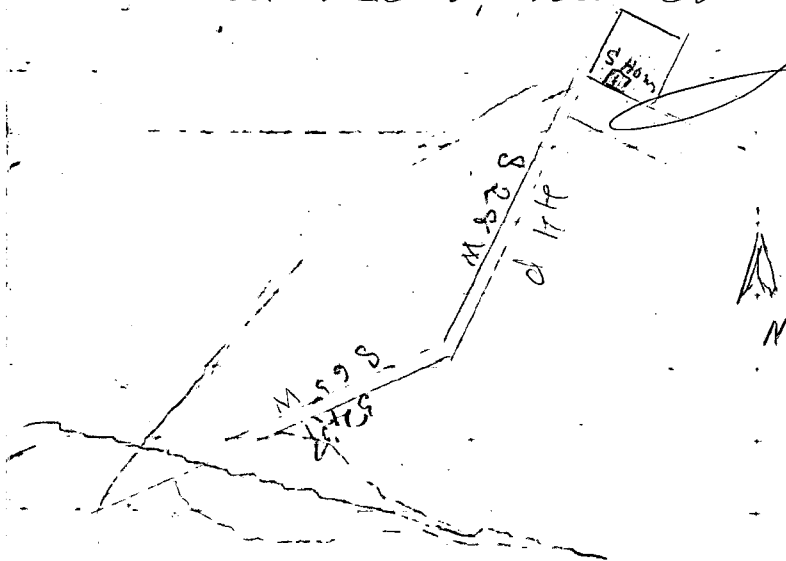

 said order (having been severally sworn or af-
 firmed as therein directed) have viewed
 said road and are of opinion that the
 same is useless inconvenient and burdensome
 and ought therefore to be vacated and should
 be supplied by a road commencing at a
 point on the old road at or near the School
 house in Janesville thence South twenty eight
 degree West forty four perches to a post
 thence South about sixty five degrees West
 fifty four and one half perches to the
 intersection of the old road.
