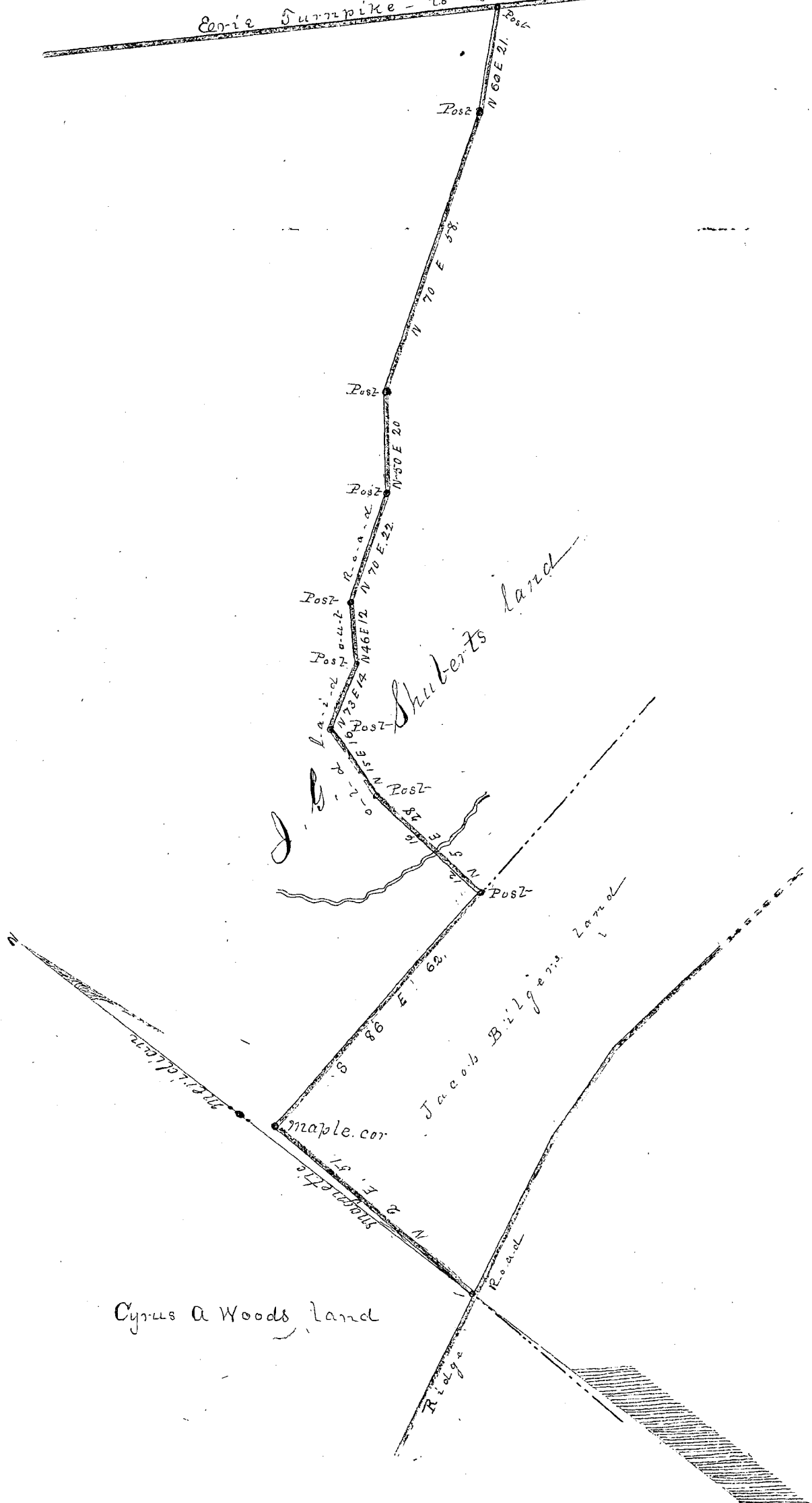

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the *Eighth* day of *January*, A. D. 187*6*, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of, in said county *Bloom*, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from *Erie Turnpike to ridge Road in Bloom Township* *pass at or near the* *House of Samuel Place, at or near the line* *of C. A. Woods land in said Township*

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint *J. W. Moore Westley Horn & Johnston Holden* who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

To the Honorable Judges of the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield county

We the undersigned Viewers appointed by the foregoing order of Court to view the road therein described. do Report. That in pursuance of said appointment after having first given public notice of more than five days of the time & place of said View by advertisements put up according to Law and having given notice to owners of Land through which said road was intended to pass of the same. We all met and being first duly affirmed we did proceed to view and lay out and do return for Public use the following road Viz. Beginning at a point on the Ridge road where the line of Cyrus A. Woods and Jacob Bilger crosses the same thence by said line North to a Maple corner 51 perches on line of land of J. E. Shubert. Thence by said Shubert & line of Jacob Bilger East 62 perches to a Post -- Then by old vacated road N 5° E 28 perches, N 15° E 16 perches " N 73° E 14 perches " N 46° E 12 perches N 70° E 22 perches " N 6, 5 1/2° E 20 perches " N 70° E 58 perches N 60° E 21 perches to the Erie Turnpike, a plat or draft of which we hereto annex. No damages claimed by any one by reason of the laying out & locating said road.
