Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 28 day of Mar, A. D. 1876, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the townships of, ~~in said county Beccana & Knox~~, setting forth that they had ~~under great inconvenience~~ ~~for the want of a road or highway leading from~~ Asking to have the farm of ~~Samuel Shoff~~ annexed to Madera Independent School District for school purposes

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Jas Michell Joe Alexander & Geo Hager

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with ~~annexation~~ impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said ~~road~~; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such ~~road~~, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a ~~road~~, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary ~~for public convenience~~, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.



To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Session of the Peace in and for the County of Clearfield we the persons appointed by the annexed order of Court in regard to annexing the farm of Samuel Shoff to Maderer Independent School District do report: That after giving due public Notice of the time and place of meeting we met agreeably thereto on the 18. day of May A.D 1875 and after being duly sworn according to law we viewed the farm of the said Samuel Shoff in regard to the purpose above named and [REDACTED] the same very inconvenient we are of the opinion that it is expedient to annex the same to the Maderer Independent School District for School purposes. As follows viz; To be taken from Muoy Township Beginning at a Rock on the west Bank of Clearfield Creek thence west 14 per to Rock thence N. 27 W. 25 to Rock thence west 19 1/4 per to Rock thence by John McConnell 842 E. 93 per to corner of original district thence by same 842 E. 71 P. to Clearfield Creek thence down Clearfield Creek to Beg. Con. 78 a. 135 p. (To be taken from Breamie Township) Beginning at a Birch on west side of Clearfield Creek on line of original district thence by same N. 42 W. 244 per thence by residue of John Mc. Connell Survey 848 1/2 a. thence by same 842 E. 48.8 per thence by same 846 W. 50 per thence by the John Callan Survey 842 E. 136 per to Clearfield Creek thence down said Creek the several corners and distances to the Beginning Con. 107 a. 109 per.



The unshaded part shows the original district, the shaded part containing 78 a. 135 is that part of the annexed part taken from Knox Township being part of a survey in the name of Peter Whiteside. The shaded part containing 107 a. 109 $\frac{1}{4}$ is that part of the annexed part taken from Beccaria Township is part of a survey in the name of John McCullough both being parts of the farm of Samuel Shoff.
