Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 28 day of Mar, A. D. 1876, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of, in said county Beccana & Knox, ~~setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from~~ Asking to have the farm of Samuel Shoff annexed to Madera Independent School District for School purposes

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Jas. Michell Jos. Alexander & Geo. Hagerty

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said ~~annexation~~; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such ~~annexation~~, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a ~~road~~, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary ~~to be made~~, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

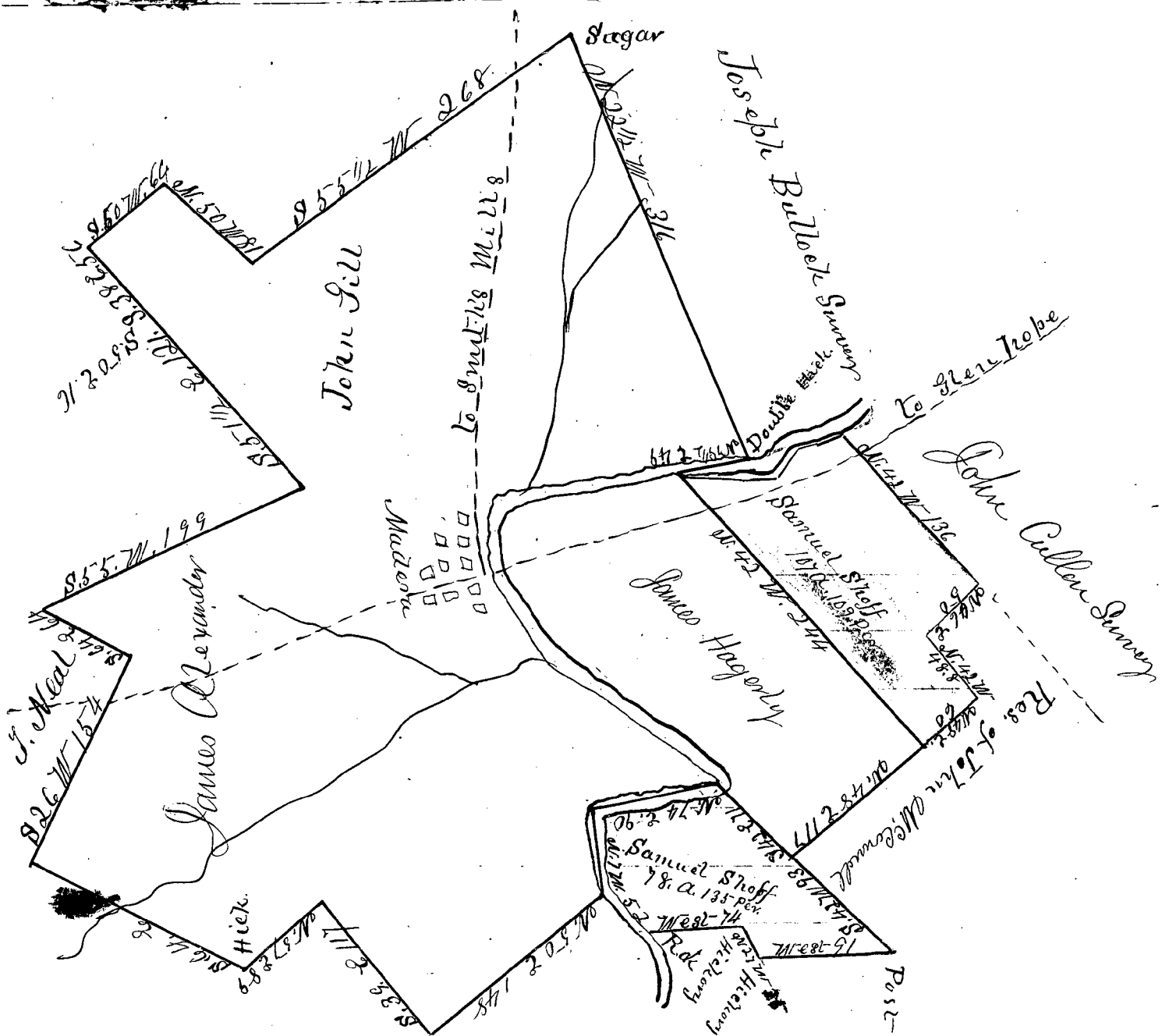

That after giving due public notice of the time
and place of meeting we met agreeably thereto on
the 18. day of May A. D 1875 and after being
duly sworn according to law we viewed the farm
of the said Samuel Shoff in regard to the purpose above
named and find ~~that the same is~~ the same very
inconvenient we are of the opinion that it is expedient
to annex the same to the Madera Independent School

Cen. 78 a. 135 p. (To be taken from Breanin Township) Beginning
at a Birch on west side of Clearfield Creek on line of original dis-
trict thence by same N. 42 W 244 per thence by residue of John M. C.
Connell Survey S. 48 W 60 thence by same S. 42 E. 48.8 per. thence by same
S. 46 W 30 per. thence by the John Cullen Survey S. 42 E. 136 per. to
Clearfield Creek thence down said Creek the several courses and
distances to the Beginning Cen. 107 a. 109 Per. ———
