Your petitioners being newly
~~residents of Clearfield Township in~~
said County respectfully represent:

That by report filed May 21st 1877.
confirmed nisi June 2nd 1877. and confirmed
absolute Dec. 5th 1877. a road was laid
out in said township, from David Askey's
place to near The Fairmount School House,
that after confirmation of said road but be-
fore an order to open issued a petition
for vacate was presented and report in favor
of vacation of said road made, which at
March term 1878. was set aside for technical
irregularity; and on April 26th 1878 an
order to open said road issued which
is now in the supervisors hands and
about to be executed if not already ex-
ecuted. Your petitioners pray your
honorable Court to reconsider the original
report and the confirmation absolute
thereof for the following reasons;

1. The said road as laid out is only
a private road in fact although report-
ed as a public road, and only accom-
modates David Askey and not the public.

2. That those of your petitioners who petitioned for the said road did so upon the representation of David Askey that the purpose of the petition was to obtain a private road.

3. Third The viewers agreed upon a private road and signed a report accordingly which was subsequently changed by attaching the draft and names of viewers to another report for a public road prepared by Chas Selman one of the viewers at the request of David Askey and without the action or consent of the other viewers, as your petitioners are informed and believe.

4. That the report of said viewers contains no report or mention of damages whatever.

5. The road as laid out passes diagonally through the entire property of Frank Jennie for a distance of one hundred and fourteen perches, almost running his place. He has but little fence timber for fencing this, which now passes through his fresh crops.

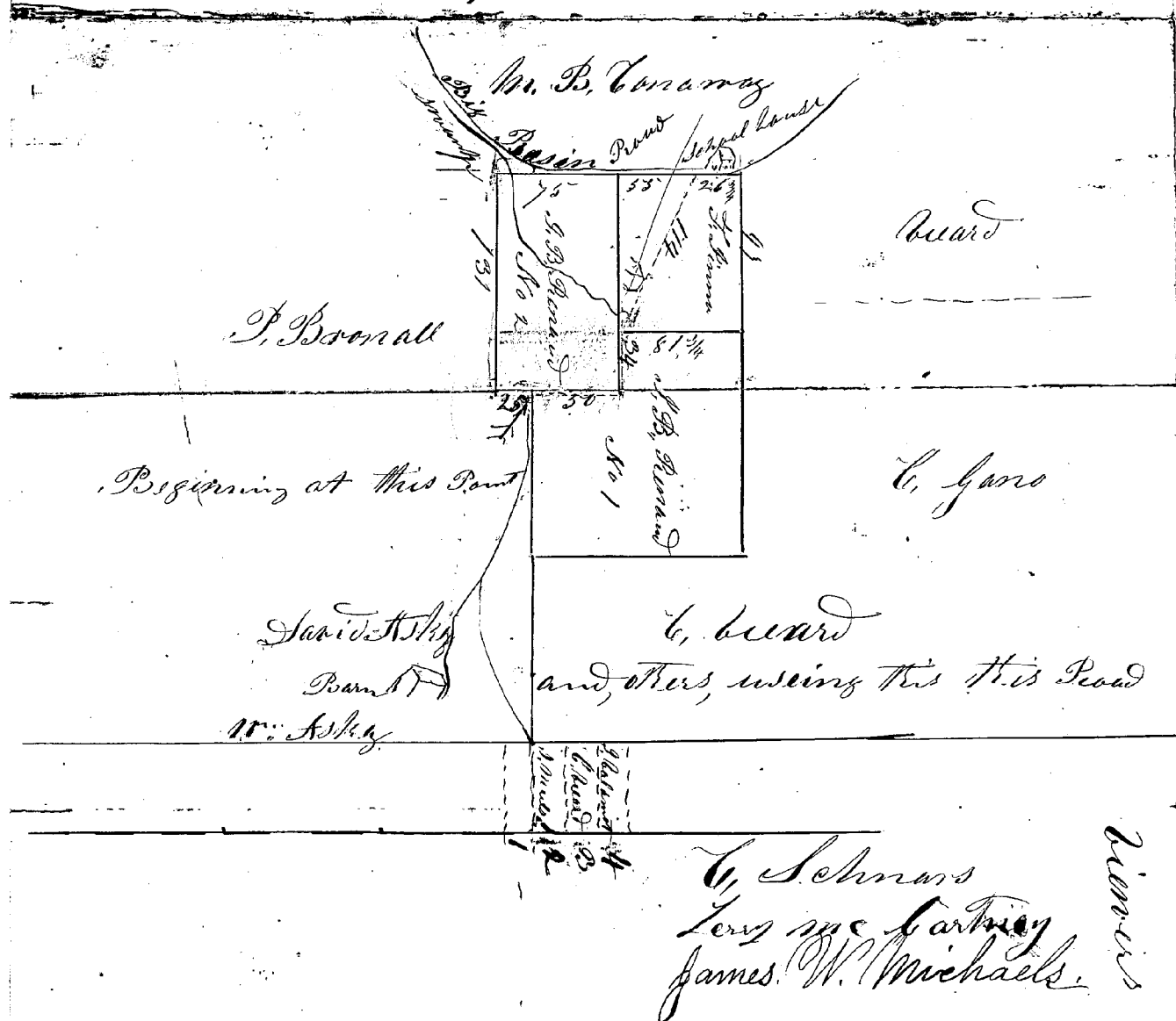

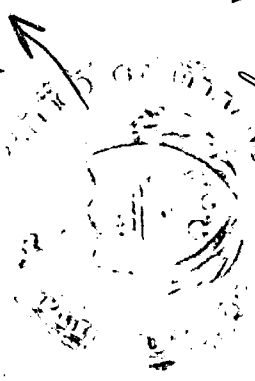

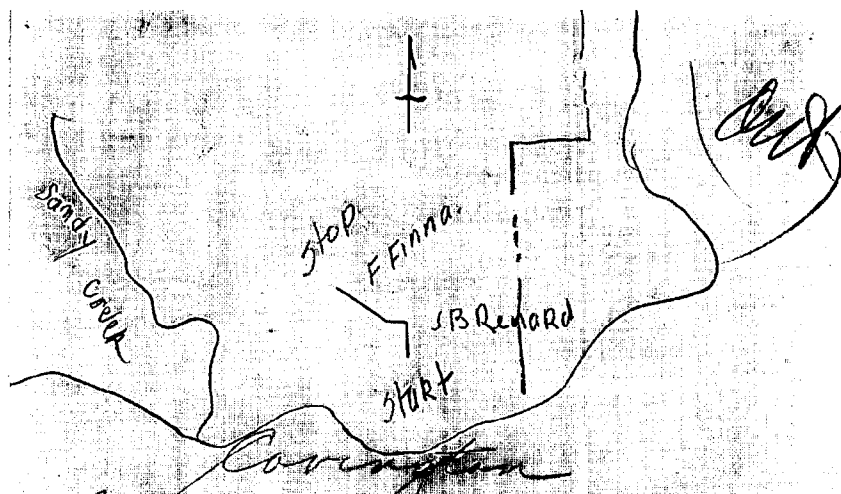
