ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

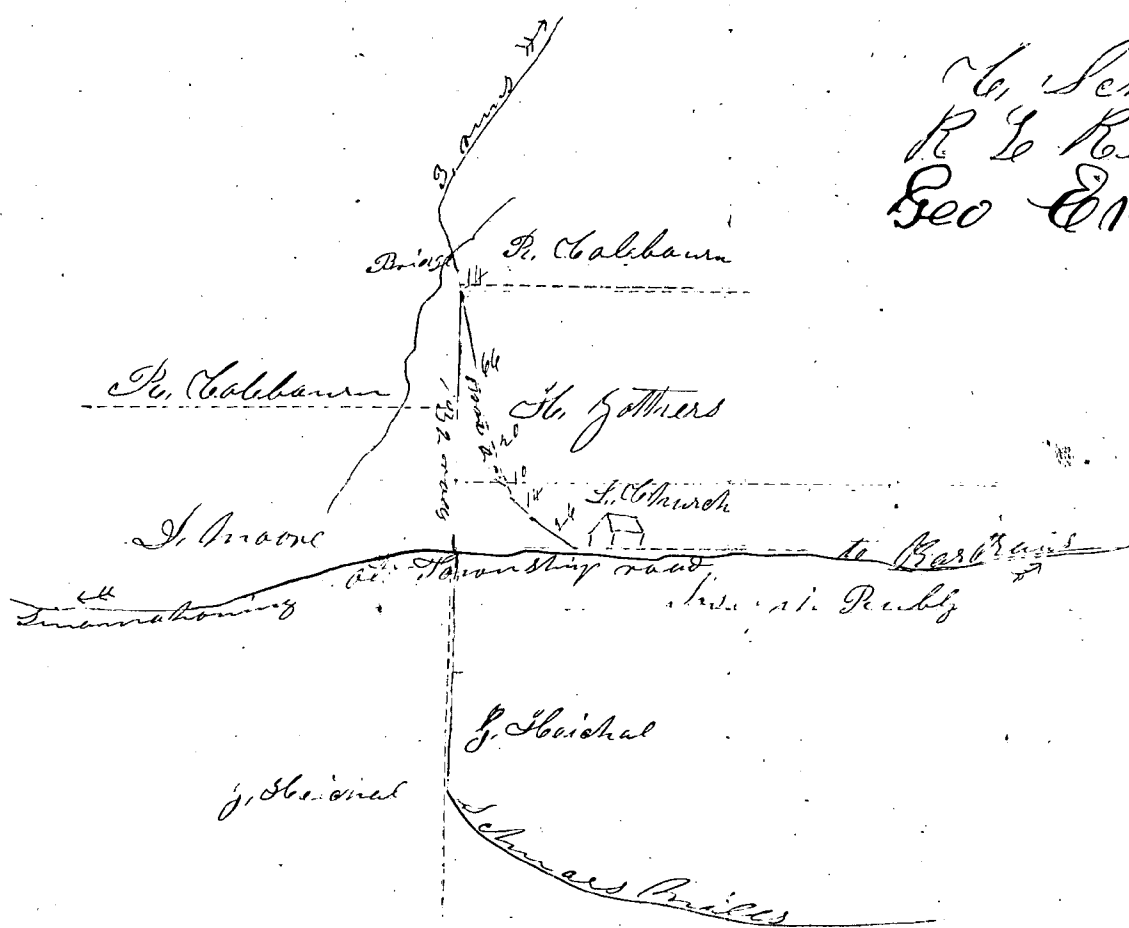
At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 1st day of Oct A. D. 1878, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Karthaus, in said county, setting forth that ~~they~~ ^{has lately been laid out} ~~labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from~~ Three Runs to Schnarrs Mill in Karthaus Township

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Charles Schnarrs ^{Vacate Supply} J. H. Potter ^{Reitor} and George Emerick, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.

The undersigned persons
appointed by the within order of Court, to view, and lay out
the Road therein mentioned, all being yemenet, and first severally
sworn, according to Law, do report that in pursuance of said
order we have viewed and laid out, and vacated, that part of the
Road, from the Lutheran Church, at the old Township road
leading from Bartrams, to Sinnamahoning, — Beginning at
said Church, thence N. 30 E. 26 rods, thence N. 45 E. 14 rods
thence N. 75 E. 10 rods, thence N. 75 E. 20 rods, thence N. 80 E. 66 rods
thence N. 82 E. 14 rods, to, near Richard Calbourns bridge, making
150 rods, to be vacated, } Thence on to bridge, Beginning near
R. Calbourns Bridge, thence S. 81 W. 14 rods, thence N. 87 W. 118
rods, to the old Township Road, making 132 rods, to latter being
18 rods shorter, and, on good ground & less grade, No damage
to parties along the Road, and we further report, that before
proceeding to view the aforesaid road we gave Public Notice thereof
by three, or more, advertisements put up in public places, in the
vicinity, of the contemplated route, of said road, for five days or more
before
we view & we also do report the same necessary
for a Public Road — with the courses and distant, as stated, with a
Plot of the same, Surveyed May 16th 1838
