To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the County of Clearfield

The undersigned viewers appointed in and by virtue of the Order of Court hereto annexed Respectfully Report:

That in pursuance of said Order they first gave public notice of the time and place of the meeting of the viewers, by advertisements duly posted in public places in the townships of Boggs, for more than five days previous to making the view, and having all met upon the ground, and being duly sworn, proceeded to examine the road proposed for vacation, and now return the said road by the following courses and distances for vacation. Beginning at the line of Walter Stewart Survey, thence South 85° degrees west five ¹⁰ rods, then South $21\frac{1}{2}$ degrees west twelve rods, South 48° degrees west ten rods to Erie Turnpike, and which in its present location is inconvenient and burdensome to the public, and very injurious to private property, and which we unanimously recommend for vacation. 

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 28 day of March, A. D. 1877, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township ~~in said county,~~ ^{invocation of} setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from the tract line of Walter

Beggs ~~to the Erie Turnpike the said Road~~
~~being lately made along the line of said Walter~~
~~Stewart Survey to the Turnpike aforesaid~~

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ~~lay out~~ ^{vacate} the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Samuel Lambert, Edward Albert, John Stone

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for ~~said road~~ ^{vacation}; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to ~~lay out~~ ^{vacate} the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
