That in pursuance of said Order they first gave public notice of the time and place of the meeting of the viewers, by advertisements duly posted in public places in the township of Boggs, for more than five days previous to making the view, and having all met upon the ground, and being duly sworn, proceeded to examine the road proposed for vacation, and now return the said road by the following courses and distances for vacation, Beginning at the line of Walter Stewart Survey, thence South ^{83°} degrees west five ⁷⁰/₁₀₀ perches South 21° degrees west twelve perches. South 48° degrees west ten perches to Erie Turnpike, and which in its present location is inconvenient and burdensome to the public, and very injurious to private property, and which we unanimously recommend for vacation. 
