Court & also as to the damages arising by reason
thereof. And they will ever pray.

Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the _____ day of _____, A. D. 1877, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Greenwood*, in said county _____, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience

for the want of a road or highway leading from *a point in the in the Ket Tanning Road on the top Curry Run Hill to a point in the Public Road at or near David Sees in Greenwood Township*

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Samuel Widemire, James Dalrymple and David McLaughlin

to, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to the _____ of their appointment with

impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them

agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to

the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the

shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make

report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same

necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft

thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improve-

ments through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter

Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state

that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

We the persons appointed
by the within order of Court to view
and lay out a road from a point in the
Hittington road on top of Curry Run Hill, to
a point in the Public road at or near
David Lees, in Greenwood Township,

(First being sworn or affirmed
according to law) D^o Report.

That in pursuance of said order, we
have viewed, laid out and returned
for Public use, the following road
(Viz) Beginning at the Hittington road
on top of Curry Run Hill, Thence S 27° W,
16 P to a hemlock, Thence S 13° W, 68 P, to
a point in the road, Thence S 20° E 22 P,
to a point in the road, Thence S 2° W,
16 P along J. B. Rafferty's improvement to
a chestnut stump, Thence S 13½° W, 32 P
to an old dead chestnut, Thence S 2° W
11 P to a white pine, Thence S 77½° W 42 P
to a cucumber, Thence S 31° W 12 P to a
hemlock, Thence S 14½° W 28 P to a Post,
Thence S 52° W 60 P through lands of Wm
Bigler to a hemlock, Thence S 7° W 10 P
to a hem, Thence S 15° E 10 P to a white oak.

Thence S 10 W 11 P to a hemlock. Thence
S 35 W, 12 P to a maple. Thence S 10 W
20 P to a pine. Thence S 24 W 20 P to a hem-
lock. Thence S 11½ E 10 P to a post. Thence
S 27½ E 29 P to hem, Thence S 4 E 12 P
to an old red oak, Thence S 43 E 26 P to a
hemlock, Thence S 88½ E 26 P to a post,
part of the last course across the corner of
Henry Kesters field. Thence S 56½ E 40 P a-
long the line of Kester to a rock oak, Thence
S 9 E 26 P to a dead chestnut, Thence S 32
E (We here enter Greenwood Township)
18 P to a post, Thence S 50 E, 20 P to the
corner of John Johnsons clearing, Thence
East along the line of said clearing 72 P to
a hemlock, Thence S 44 E 13 P to a post.
Thence South, (at 24 P, 2 feet filling) at
72 P 3 feet filling, Thence continuing
on same course, (South) through the farm
of James and John Johnson 140 P to a
post in the field, Thence S 51 E 17 P to a hem-
lock, Thence South 14 P along the line of Wm.
Bigler and James Johnson, Thence S 18 W,
10 P to a big hemlock on the line of Wm
Bigler, Thence S 31½ E 15 P to a white oak,
Thence S 55 E 22 P to a hem, Thence S 37,
E (through the Irwin tract) 26 P to Job Curreys
corner, Thence South along the Curry line
56 P to a post by side of clearing, Thence
S 80 E 72 P through Curreys farm, Thence
continuing on the same course (S 80 E) whole

~~distance 98 P the end of David Lees lane,~~
Thence S 66½ E 28 P to a corner in the road,
Thence S 25 E 72 P to the public road near
David Lees, being the terminus of the
order, making whole distance three and
a half miles and fifty Perches,

Viewed, laid out, and returned for Pub-
lic use the 13th & 14th days of Sept 1877, and
Signed by order of said viewers.

The above Plot or draft is Seventy Perches shorter in the whole distance than the former survey from the same points.
