To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter
Sessions of the Peace in and for the County of Clearfield

petitioners humbly conceive, is altogether useless, (except
as a timber road in the winter, and for which purpose it
can be used.) This part of the road is inconvenient, and
burthensome to the inhabitants thereof.

that the said road may be vacated, agreeably to the act of
the General Assembly in such case made and pro-
vided, and they will ever pray, &c.
