To the Honourable the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas of the County of Cleary, now composing a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for said County

The petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Bell in said County, humbly sheweth: that ~~your~~ a road has been long since laid out from the old Orr property on the hill to the Chest Creek Road in Bell Township which road your petitioners humbly conceive is now become useless, inconvenient and burthensome to the inhabitants thereabouts, as also a part of the Chest Creek Road from the end of the bridge over the run near Robert Mahaffey's Grist Mill, to a point of woods between said bridge and Wm Mahaffey's in Bell Township as also the road from said bridge to Samuel Rauffmans, in said Township. The road from the old Orr residence to the Chest Creek road to be vacated entire to the said road and and the balance of the road across the Creek to the lane on the premises of James Meekilly to be supplied: as also the road from the end of the bridge aforesaid to the point of woods near William Mahaffey's to be also supplied, as also the road leading to Samuel Rauffmans, from said bridge a change to be made from the bridge through Rott Mahaffey improvement to the woods so as to connect on old view: Your petitioners therefore humbly pray your honour to appoint proper persons to review, vacate and supply such parts as above stated agreeable to the act of the General Assembly in such cases made and provided

ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 22nd day of June A. D. 1876, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Bell in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from the O. H. Orr property on the Hill to the Chest Creek road in Bell Twp. and from the Chest Creek ^{Bridge} near Robt. Mahoffey's Grist mill to a point of Woods near W. Mahoffey's in Bell Twp. & from said Bridge to a point near Kaufmans in said Twp. the road thus created to be supplied by a road starting at a point in public road near Mahoffey's lane thence to and across Chest Creek by Bridge into road to be supplied or laid out by running from point of Woods on Chest Creek Road near W. Mahoffey's part end of Bridge to a Bridge over Run & from there to a point in road near Sam. Kaufmans And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon the Court upon due consideration had of the premises; do order and appoint Owen L. Miller Surveyor and Smith Bell Viewers who. after being respectively sworn or to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.

Thence south sixty nine deg. west, eighteen perches Thence south, ~~sixty two~~ ~~seven~~ seventy six deg. west, twenty seven perches Thence south, eighty five deg. west, twenty two perches. Thence south seventy one deg. west, eighteen perches. Thence south sixty four deg. west eighteen perches Thence south seventy two deg. west, eighteen perches. Thence south fifty five deg. west, forty perches. Thence south seventy eight deg. west fifty six perches Thence North, seventy six deg. west sixteen perches. Thence North sixty deg. west nineteen perches. Thence South sixty deg. west fifty six perches. Thence North seventy three deg. west forty eight perches to bridge over run near Mahaffys Grist Mill & Also vacated the following road - leading from Kauffman's to Chest Creek Road, commencing at the woods above R. Mahaffys improvement Thence South twenty three deg. west thirty one perches to said Road. Also vacated a part of the Chest Creek road beginning where the road leading to the old Orr property leaves the chest creek road. Thence South thirty three deg. East forty four perches to above point of wood near Wm Mahaffys. and have supplied the following roads, to wit: beginning at above the point of wood in the Chest Creek road near Wm. Mahaffys. Thence North forty five deg. west thirty six perches Thence North, thirty three deg. west ten perches to the upper side of a rock. Thence North forty four deg. west, twenty perches to bridge across the run near said Grist Mill. Thence North forty two deg. East, thirty two perches to woods above Mahaffys improvement on the Kauffman road. Also supplied the following road, beginning in Meettley's lane. Thence South eighty four deg. East, twelve perches. Thence over the bridge across Chest Creek North forty eight deg. East, fourteen perches to intersect new road at said Robert Mahaffys Grist Mill in Bell Township.
