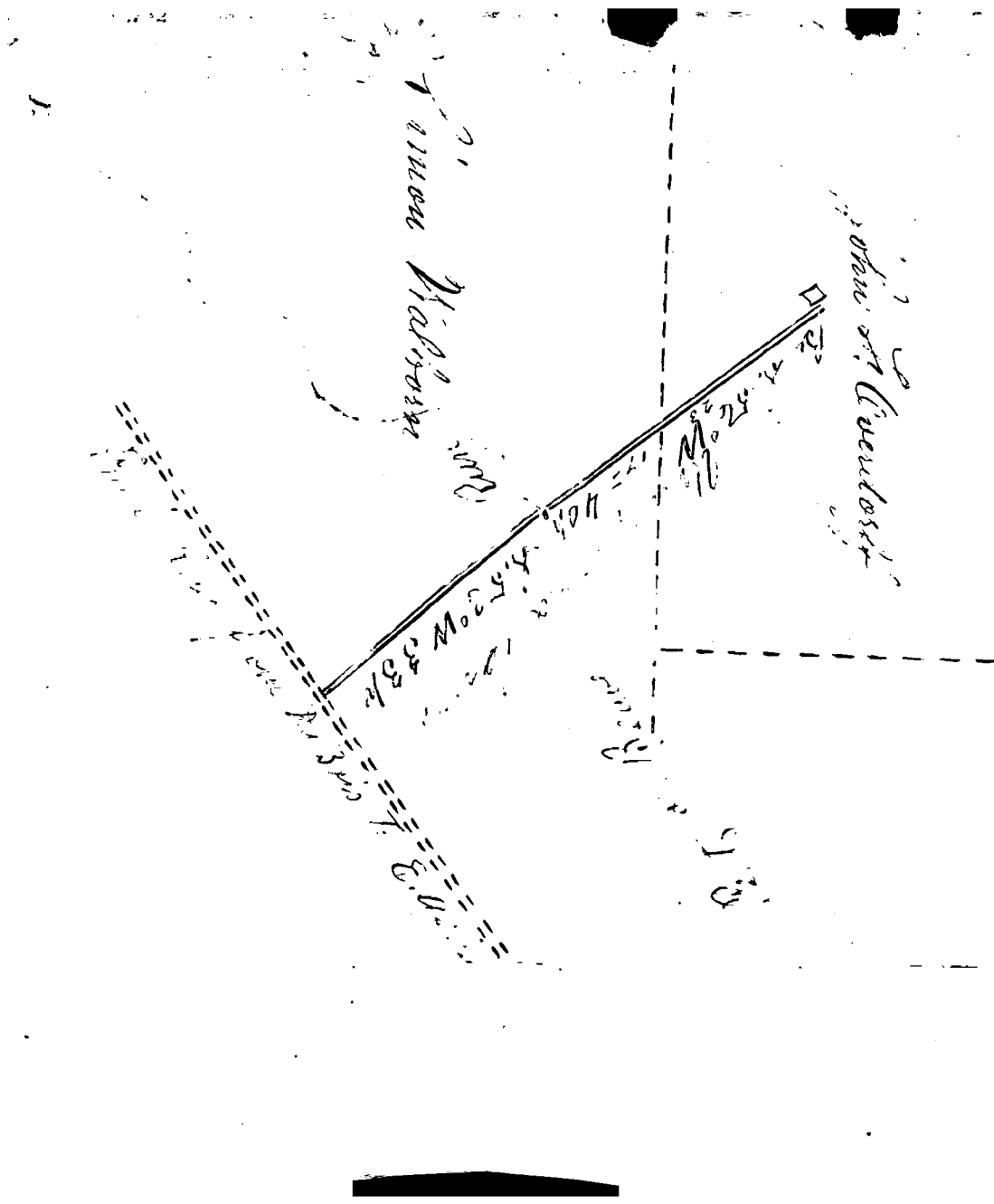

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court
of Quarter Sessions of Cleaveland County

We the undersigned viewers appointed
by the annexed order of Court to view and lay
out the roads therein mentioned respectfully
report: -

That having given due and public notice
of the time and place of said view by printed
handbills as required by the act of Assembly,
we met at the time and place of said view
appointed and after being duly sworn or affirm-
ed according to law, and all the viewers be-
ing present, we went upon the ground proposed
for said view, and having viewed the same
we report for Private use the following road
to wit: - Beginning at Residence of John H.
Overdorff Thence South Fifty-six (56) degrees West
Twenty-Three (23) perches to line of lands of Simon
Walborn and by same bearing through wood lands
of said Walborn Seventeen (17) perches more being a dis-
tance of forty (40) perches to Beaver Run: Thence
through woodlands of said Walborn South Fifty-two
(52) degrees West Thirty-Three (33) perches to inter-
sect the public road leading from Dubois to the
stream. This change we as Elijah Ashenfitters
a plan or draft whereof is herunto annexed which
said road we report as necessary and our further
report no damages to accrue from said road

ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 24 day of June A. D. 1878, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of ^{John Overdorff an} ~~sundry~~ ^{now sandy} inhabitant of the township of ~~Grady~~ ^{Grady}, in said county, setting forth that ~~they~~ he labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from ~~residence of John Overdorff to the~~ ^{residence of John Overdorff to the}

Township to Public Road leading from DuBois to the Crown Hill Low-pike near Elijah Ashenfelters

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint David Reams & A Dixon & J. H. Paul, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioner, as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.
