To the Honorable Judges of the Court  
of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield Co. Pa.


In pursuance of the order hereto annexed, we  
the undersigned viewers appointed by your Honorable  
Court, after due notice, as provided by law, met upon  
the premises on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of October 1848, and after  
being duly sworn according to law, proceeded to view  
the premises and after careful consideration thereof,  
vacated that portion of the said public road as follows  
to wit. From a Stake in the township road near the East  
end of the Swamp Siding on the A. V. R. R. thence along  
the north side of said R. R. through a swamp (or pond)  
where a long bridge would be necessary in an easterly direction  
to a cut in the R. R. thence southerly across the R. R. track  
and easterly around a high Knoll thence northerly across the  
R. R. track at the east end of the cut which would be very  
dangerous to travelers going in either direction, as a train of  
cars could not be seen until you got upon the R. R. track.  
Thence easterly along the north side of the track to the Twp.  
road at the Widow Brooks farm, and supplying the same by  
a new road between the said points as follows to wit.

Beginning at the point above mentioned, at the East end of Swamp  
Siding thence S. 28° E. Six rods E. then half fut to a stake marked No.  
one on the South side of the A. V. R. R. thence S. 48° E. Fifty four rods  
nine fut to a stake marked No. 6. Thence S. 72 1/4° E. One hundred and eighty  
four rods, (parallel with the R. R. track) to stake No. 16. Thence S. 84°  
E. Forty nine rods six  $\frac{3}{4}$  one half fut to a Stake at township road at Widow  
Brooks' place. Which portion vacated we are satisfied would  
be an improper location and inconvenient and burdensome to  
the said township, although the same is not yet opened, and the  
portion laid out in place thereof we deem necessary for  
a public road, and the owners of improved land

## ROAD. VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of October A. D. 1878, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of ~~Brady~~, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from DuBois Station on the A. & R. R. to the Township road for near the farm of the Widow Brooks.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint ~~James C. Baird~~ <sup>Vacation Supp</sup> C. F. Miller and ~~Joseph P. Taylor~~, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, <sup>Vacation Supp</sup> they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly

whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.
