## ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

### Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of September A. D. 1878, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Pike Township*, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from *Josiah Thompson* in *Lawrence Twp* to *Andrew Cupples* in *Pike Twp* also to vacate such Portions of the Public Road Open from *Josiah Thompson* aforesaid to *Andrew Cupples* in *Pike Twp* as will by reason of the laying out of said proposed become useless.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint *James Mitchell* *James Thompson* and *John Dunlap*, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same.
