To The Honorable, The Judges within
nained: We the undersigned, appointed
by the annexed order do report; That
in pursuance thereof, after having been
severally duly sworn and affirmed, all
the viewers appointed by said order, viewed
the ground proposed for the within men-
tioned road, and we do agree that there
is occasion for a road as desired by the
petitioners, and that the same is necessa-
ry for a public road. And having had
respect to the shortest distance and the
best ground for such road, we have
laid out in such manner as shall, in
our opinion, do the least injury to private
property, and as far as practicable agree-
ably to the desire of the petitioners, and
do return for public use the following
described road, to wit: Beginning at a
post, ^{in public road} 6 ft. west of corner of land of Charles
Brown, on land of Stephen Fletcher; thence
north on said Fletcher's land fifty-eight rods
 $9/10$ perches to post in public road near John
Labordes' farm. The undersigned further
report that no damages ensue to any one
through whose land said road passes from
the opening of the same. And we further
report that we have inquired and do vacate
the following described public road to wit:

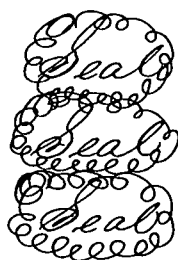
Beginning at the post last above mentioned; thence S. 39° W. thirty-two perches to a post; thence S. 63° W. twenty-two perches to a post; thence S. 83½° W. twenty perches to a post in public road leading from Rockton Mills to Huston township, which by reason of the laying out of the first mentioned ^{road} has become useless. We further report, that before the said view, public notice of the time and place of the meeting of the viewers was given by advertisements put up at three of the most public places in the vicinity - ten days before said meeting, and we annex a plot or draft of said road laid out, stating the courses and distances, and noticing briefly the improvements through which the same passes, and also a description and draft of the road vacated.

ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 23rd day of September A. D. 1877, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Union, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from John Labord's farm to a road leading from Rockton Mills to Huston Township

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to ^{review} ~~view~~ and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint George C. Kirk Charles Brown and David Dressler, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to ^{review} ~~view~~ the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.
