the Citizens of Goshen and Lawrence
Townships - That to build such road
would be at a much ~~greater~~ cost
than the Citizens undersigned at
first anticipated and also not the
road which they believed would
be laid out - That the greater
majority of the Citizens live above
the road as laid out by the
surveyors and consequently would
derive no benefit from it as
will appear from a draft annexed
to the report of said surveyors now
before your Court -

Your Petitioners therefore
beg leave to remonstrate against
the formation of said and humbly
pray the Court not to confirm
the same -

The undersigned Citizens
of Goshen and Lawrence Townships
respectfully represent -

dated 24 Jan 1878 That under and
order of the Court we did lay out a Public
Road in Goshen Township leading from
a Public Road at or near the end
of lane on A. A. Reed's land to a
point on a Public road near
George Meanders House the men
appointed by your honorable Court
being James Marshall Philip Reeci
and A. C. Shirey did go upon the
land designated by the order of
your honorable Court and did lay
out a road as follows: Beginning
at a turn of road or lane on A. A.
Reed's farm thence through improved
land of A. A. Reed S 84° E 52 Per
to post and line of land of Lewis
Brown thence S $88^{\circ} 2'$ E 14 per to High
pine stump thence S 73° E $9^{\frac{1}{2}}$
per to White Pine thence N $77^{\frac{1}{2}}$ E
 $10^{\frac{1}{2}}$ per to Hem thence N 38° E $7^{\frac{1}{2}}$
per to Pine Stump thence N 22° E
 $30^{\frac{1}{2}}$ per Hem Stump thence N 35°
E 18 per to Hem Stump thence N $17^{\frac{1}{2}}$ E
 $8^{\frac{1}{2}}$ per Hem Stump thence N 59° E
at 23 per to Public road near George
