

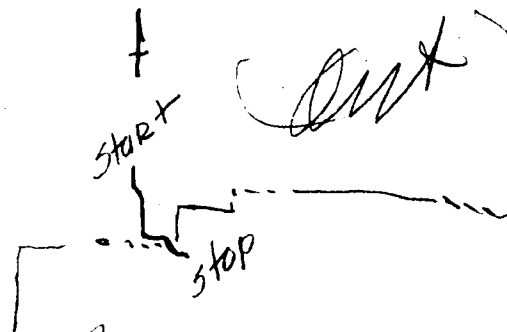

persons duly qualified to view the ground proposed
for said road, and to lay out the same according
to law.

ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 18 day of Mar A. D. 1879, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Sandy Brady, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from Wm Hands in Sandy Township to intersect the Public road near Elias Smileys in Brady Township in said county

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Geo C Kirk Clerk Goodlander and Samuel Postlethwait, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.

We the persons appointed by the
within order of court, to view and lay
out the road therein mentioned, do report
that in pursuance of said order, and
after having been duly sworn, we have
viewed and laid out and do return for
public use, the following road, namely:
Beginning at a post in public road near
Wm. Hardey, in Sandy Township; thence S. $3\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W.
through partly improved and partly timber
lands of J. J. Pentz's heirs, thirty-four $\frac{7}{10}$
perches to a Hemlock; thence S. 31° E. twentyei-
ght and a half perches to a Hemlock; thence
S. $1\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E. partly through wood & partly improved
land of said Pentz's heirs, eightyfour and $\frac{9}{10}$
perches to a post in line of Jas. Spafford's
land; thence S. $87\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. on division line between
lands of said Pentz's heirs, and said Spafford
fifty perches to a post; two per. west of San-
dy Township line; thence S. $36\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E., through
wood land of Elias Smiley, fifty and a half
perches to a post in line of Fred. Smiley's
land; thence S. $87\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. on line between lands of
said Elias and Fred. Smiley, twenty and
a half perches to a post in public road near
said Elias Smiley, in Brady Township, The
plot or draft whereof is hereunto annexed

We further report that there are no damages resulting to any one through whose land said road passes.
