Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint David Beams Martin Luther and Benjamin Brockton, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as freeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.

D. 1889, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Orady, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from at or near the line of Elias Lines & Joseph Seyler ft. on road leading from Sho Lines John Bailen and thence

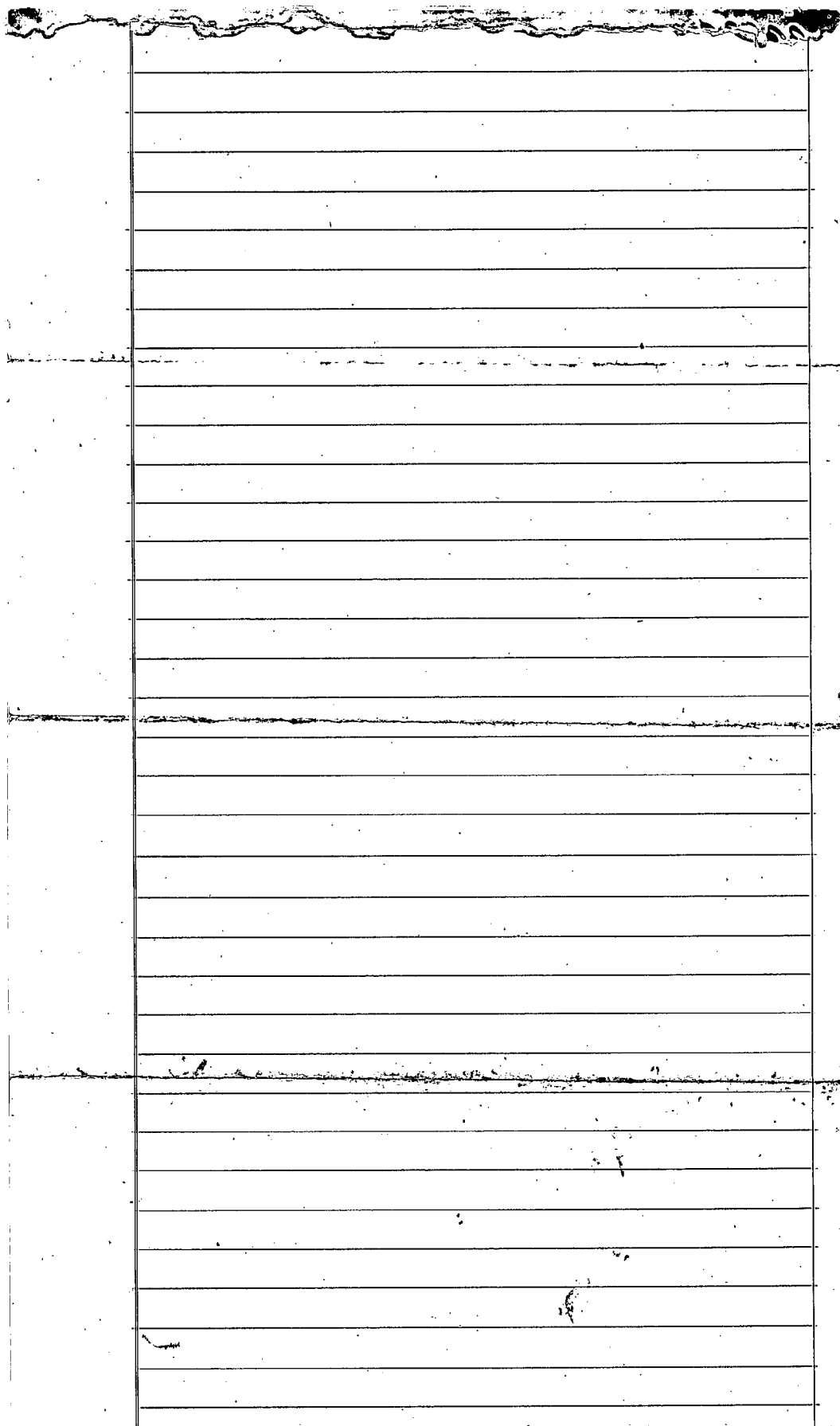

We the undersigned viewers appointed by
the annexed order of Court to view and lay
out the road therein mentioned respectfully report

That having given due and public notice
of the time and place of said view by
handbills as required by the act of Assembly,
we met at the time and place appointed and
after being duly sworn as affirmed according
to law, and all the viewers being present, we
went upon the ground proposed for said view
and having viewed the same we report for
Public use the following road to wit:

Beginning at a stone corner of lands of Geo. C. Kirk
and School House lot. Thence by line of lands of
Geo. C. Kirk; School lot; Joseph Seyler's and Eli Linn
South two and a half ($2\frac{1}{2}$) deg West One Hundred and
thirty-three and a half ($133\frac{1}{2}$) perches to a post corner
of lands of Joseph Seyler's. Thence through wood
lands of Eli Linn S. five and a half ($5\frac{1}{2}$) deg West
Sixteen and a half ($16\frac{1}{2}$) perches to a post; Thence
South twenty-five and a half ($25\frac{1}{2}$) deg West Ten (10) perches
to a large chestnut stump; Thence South One (1)
deg West Twenty (20) perches to intersect the Public's
