# ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

## Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May A. D. 1879 before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Laurence, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from Erie Turnpike to public road along river at corner of lot John Reeds in Laurence Township

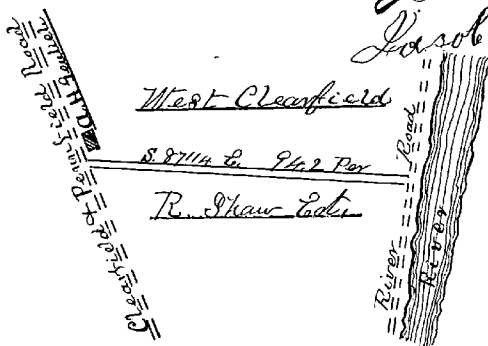
And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Jas Mitchell Jasot Gulick and J. S. Shores, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the County of Clearfield.

We the persons appointed by annexed order of Court to view and lay out the road therein mentioned do report: That after giving due public notice of the time and place of meeting we all met agreeably thereto on the sixth day of September A. D. 1879 and after being duly sworn according to law we proceeded to view the ground proposed for said road, that believing the same to be necessary we did view and lay out and do now return for public use the following road viz: Beginning at the residence of A. H. Gulick on the Clearfield and Pennfield public road thence S. 87 1/4 E. 73.2 Perches to river or road at property of John Reed. And we also further report that no damage will be caused to owners of property by the opening of said road.
