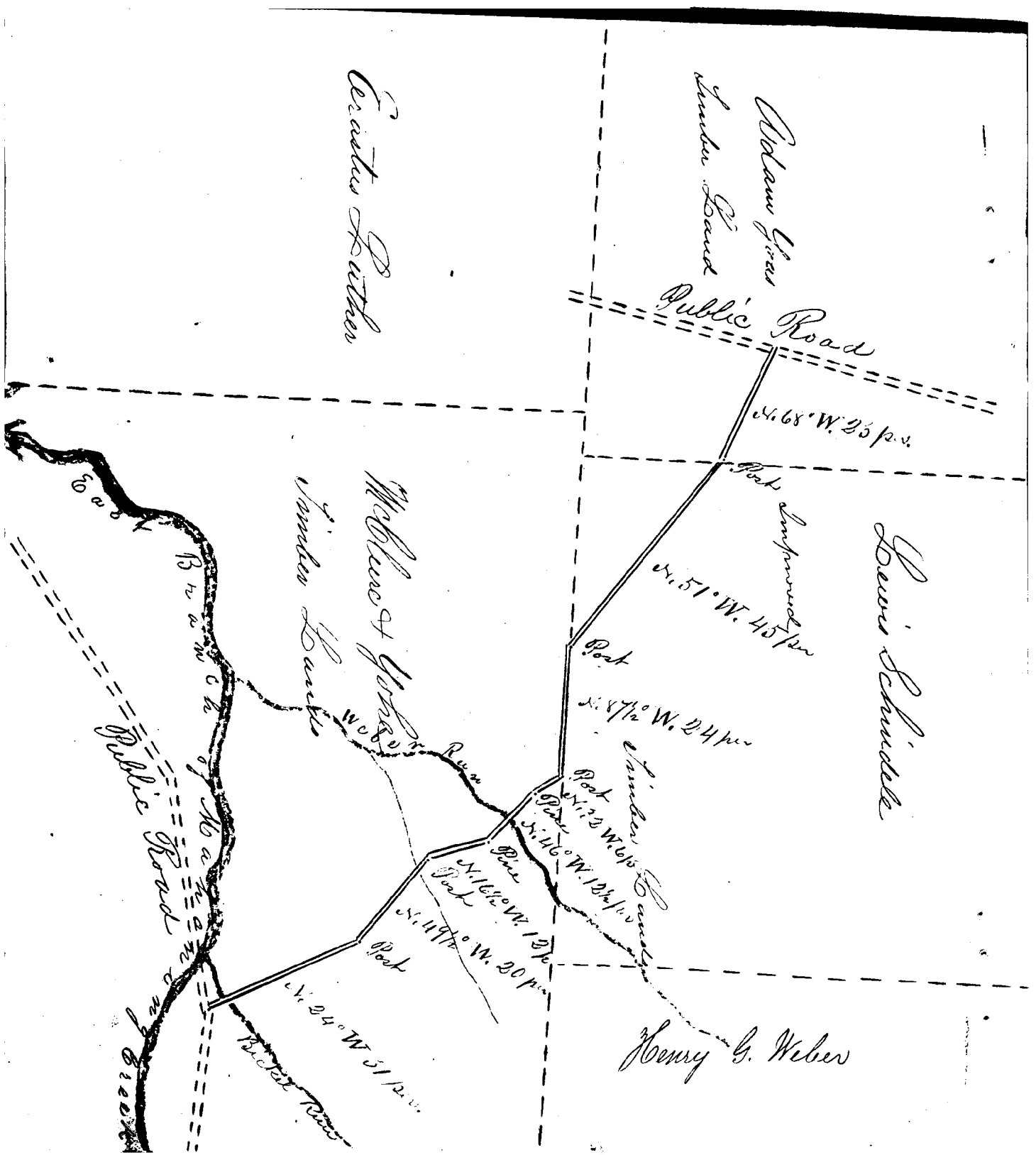
ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 23 day of May A. D. 1877, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Brady, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from the Public Road on lands of McClure & Yohe to intersect the Public road on lands of Adam Yohe in Brady Township

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint David Reams Christian Korb^{er} & J. W. Huntz, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree at there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of
Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County.

We the undersigned viewers appointed by the
annexed order of Court to view and lay out the
road therein mentioned respectfully report.---

That having given due and public notice of
the time and place of said view by written handbills
as required by the act of assembly, we met at the
time and place appointed and after being duly sworn
or affirmed according to law and all the viewers
being present we went upon the ground proposed
for said view and having viewed the same we
report for public use the following road to wit:
Beginning at a post in public road near the forks
of East Branch Bickel run on lands of
McClure & Yoke in Brady township; Thence through
lands of McClure & Yoke North 24 deg. West 31 per. to post
Thence North 49 1/2 deg. West 20 per. to post on north
bank of Spring gutter; Thence North 10 1/2 deg. West 12 per
to pine tree; Thence North 46 deg. W. 12 1/2 per to pine tree
north of Weber Run; Thence North 32 deg. W. 6 per. to
post on line of lands of Lewis Schindler; Thence by
said line North 8 1/2 deg. W. 24 per. to post; Thence
partly by private road through lands of said Schindler
North 51 deg. West 45 per. to line of lands of Adam
Yas; Thence through said lands of Adam Yas
N. 68 deg. W. 23 per. to intersect the public road
on lands of Adam Yas, a plot or draft whereof is here-
unto annexed which said road we report a necessary and
in the report no damages to { David Reams }
