whether they judge the same necessary for a public or  
private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the  
courses and distances, with reference to the improvements  
through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter  
Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they  
shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed accord-  
ing to law. By the Court.

**ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.**

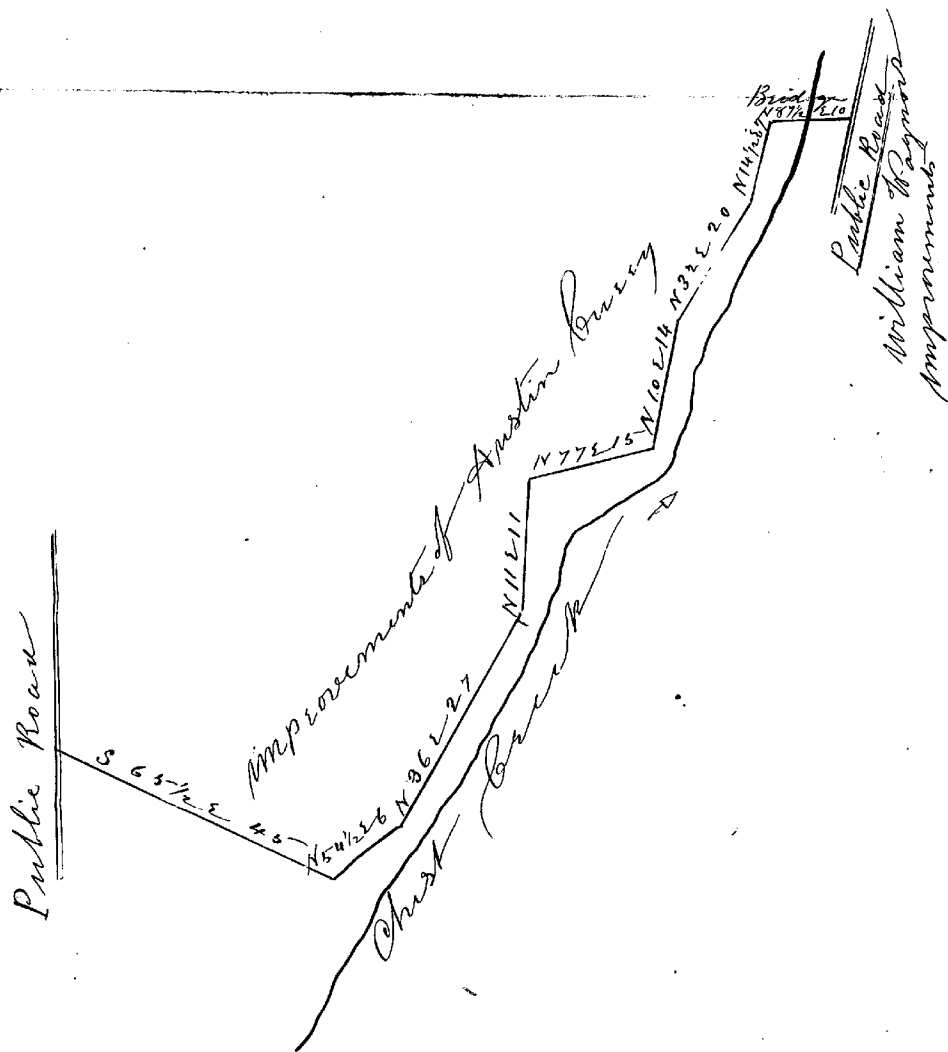
**Clearfield County, ss:**

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 13 day of January A. D. 1879, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Wheel, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from near a dwelling on the lot of at in the town of Clearfield County Penn.

To the Honorable the judge within named  
 We the persons appointed by annexed order  
 of Court do to view and lay out Road therein  
 mentioned do report: That in pursuance thereof  
 after giving due and public notice according  
 to law having been duly sworn and affirmed  
 all the viewrs appointed by said order having  
 viewed the ground proposed for the within  
 mentioned Road and the undersigned  
 viewrs do agree there is occasion for a Road  
 as desired by the petitioner and that the same  
 is necessary for a public Road and having had  
 respect to the shortest distance and best ground  
 for such Road we have laid it out in such a  
 manner as should do the least injury to private  
 property and as far as practically agreeable to the  
 desire of the petitioner and do return for public  
 use the following described Road commencing at  
 the public Road at the end of Austin Currey lane thence  
 through the improvements of Austin Currey south  
 Sixty five and a half Degrees East forty five  
 perches thence through the same North fifty four and  
 three fourths Degrees East six perches thence through  
 the same North thirty six Degrees East twenty seven  
 perches thence by the same North eleven Degrees East  
 eleven perches thence by the same North seventy  
 seven Degrees East fifteen perches thence by the  
 same North ten Degrees East fourteen perches  
 thence by the same North thirty two Degrees East  
 twenty perches thence by the same North fourteen and  
 a half Degrees East seven perches thence across  
 Chest Creek North eighty seven and a half Degrees  
 East ten perches to the public Road near William Wagoner's  
 house the entire length being one hundred and fifty  
 five perches damage done to assess the owner of ground  
 was previously notified. Witness our hands & seals this
