ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 24th day of Sept. A. D. 1877, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Bell, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from Susquehanna River near Ranchart Wetzell in Bell Township to the said Clearfield.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon the Court, upon due consideration, had of the premises, do order and appoint Edw. Muller & Thacker Ranchart Wetzell, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as

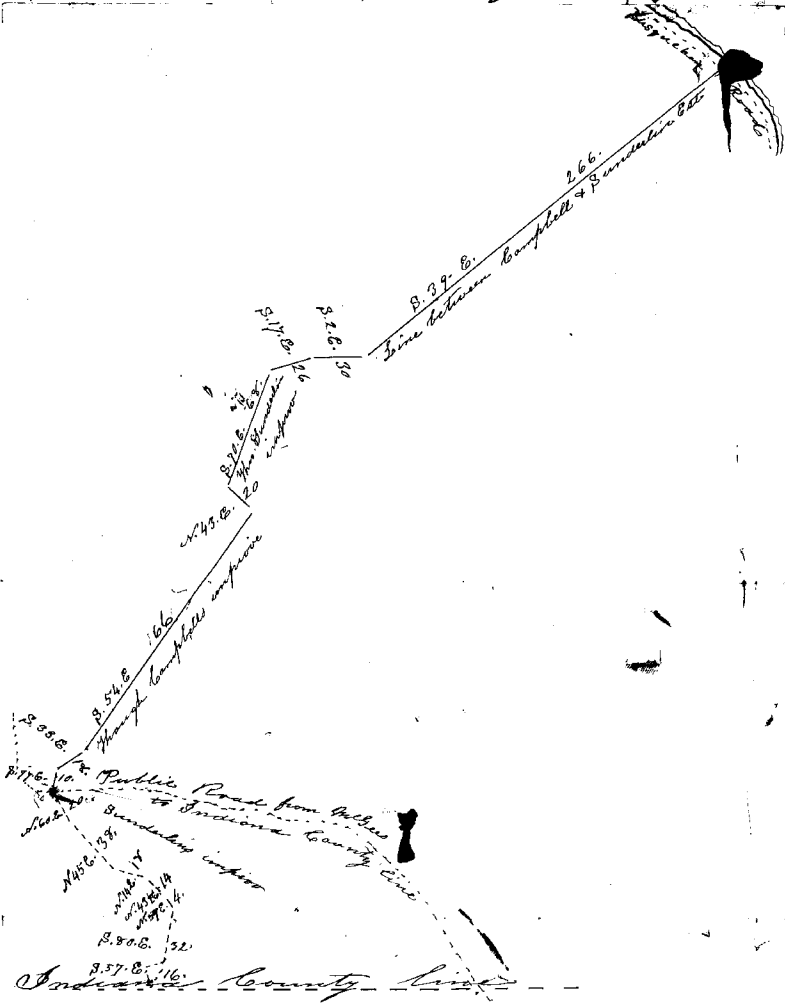
Report

To the Honorable the Judges within named.

We the subscribers, appointed by the within order of Court, to view the Road within mentioned, after being severally sworn do report: That in pursuance of the said order we have viewed the said Road and that the part first mentioned is in our opinion is useless, inconvenient and burthensome and therefore have vacated it entirely either for private or public use viz. Beginning at the Indiana County line, thence south fifty seven deg. East, sixteen per. thence, south eighty deg. east thirty two per. thence North, fifty nine deg. East four per. thence, North forty three & deg. East fourteen per thence, north fourteen deg. East, eighteen per. thence North forty five deg. East thirty eight per. thence North sixty deg. East twenty per. to public road leading from Philip McGees to the Indiana County line at or near James Martin and the following part, we in our opinion ^{think} should be left a public Road to wit. Beginning at the public road leading from Philip McGees to the ^{Indiana} County line on lands of Thos. Chunderlin back place thence South seventy seven deg. East ten per. to a post, thence South thirty three deg. East, eighteen per to maple. Thence through lands of J. W. Campbell South, fifty four deg. East one hundred and sixty six per to line between said J. W. C. and Thos. Chunderlin thence along said line North forty three deg. East twenty per. to post, thence through lands of said Thos. Chunderlin South seventy deg. East sixty eight per to Hem. thence South seventeen deg. East twenty six per. to a stump, thence South two deg. east thirty per. to line between said Campbell and Michael Chunderlin Estate South thirty nine deg. East two hundred and fifty six per to the Pusquehanna road at or near Linchart Wetzels in Bell Twp -
