We the undersigned persons appointed by the
within Order of Court to view and vacate the
Road leading from a point in the Public Road,
near Schronover's mill, in Graham Township, to a
point in the Public Road near the United Brethren
Church in Morris Township. Respectfully report;
That having given notice of the time and place
of meeting, according to the act of assembly, and
being all present at the view of the ground
proposed for the said Road, and being all sworn
in pursuance of the said Order, we have viewed
the ground upon which the road is located, and find
a number of persons living, building, and clearing
land along the line of the said road, and
we are of opinion that the road is necessary for
the use of those settlers, as well as the public gen-
erally, and we therefore do not vacate
the said Road.

ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 3rd day of June A. D. 1877, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Morris & Graham ^{by reason} in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from a point on public road near Schoonover's Mill in Graham Township to a point on public road near United Brethren Church in Morris Township which said road has never been opened or made.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ^{Vacate} lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Samuel M. Clorkey John Leytte & A. Humphreys, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is ^{no} occasion for such road, they shall proceed to ^{Vacate} ~~lay out~~ the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.
