We the undersigned viewers appointed by the
annexed order of Court to view and lay out the road
therein mentioned respectfully report:—

That having given due and public notice of
the time and place of said view by written handbills as
~~required by the act of Assembly~~, we went at the time and
place appointed and after being duly sworn or affirmed
according to law, and all the viewers being present we went
upon the ground proposed for said view, and having
viewed the same we report for Public use the
following Road to wit:— Beginning in the Public
road leading from the Public road which runs along
the A. V. Rail Road at a point 119 perches S. E. East
from said road and 99 per. from said Rail Road
(see draft) Thence through timber lands of John Dubois
South 49 degrees East 12 per. to post; Thence South
56 deg. E. 20 per. to water beech; Thence South 23½ deg.
E. 14 per. to post; Thence South 26½ deg. East 80 per.
to a hemlock stump; 52 per. beyond the Sandy and
Union township line and on lands of Abel Dubois
Thence through said timber lands of Abel Dubois
South 59 deg. East 40 per. to a hemlock; Thence
South 67 deg. East 13 per. to a hemlock; Thence
South 81 deg. East 35 per. to a hemlock; Thence
South 84 deg. East 78 per. to a Beech; Thence
South 71 deg. East 183 per. to a dead Chestnut; Thence
South 84 deg. East 12 per. to line of lands of Charles Blau-
shard and 62 per. more through said lands to a small
hemlock; Thence South 26 per. to lands of Geo. B. Brown
and by same in private lane of Geo. B. Brown 100 per.
more being 126 per. to Public Road leading from
