The petition of the undersigned (being
over third) the qualified electors of Wood-
ward Township, Clearfield County, Penna.,
respectfully represents:

That they suffer
great inconvenience by reason of the present
location of the place in said township for
holding the general special and township
elections, for the reason that the largest body
of the voters of said township live at a re-
mote distance, and are greatly inconven-
ienced in travelling to the present place
to vote, and the present place is not a
central location in said township. They
desire that the place of holding said elec-
tions be changed to "Houtzville School House"
in said township. They therefore pray
the Court to order an election in said
township, upon the question of location
and change of place of holding said elec-
tions, and they will ever pray etc.
