To the Hon. the Judges of the Court of
Quarter Sessions in and for the County of
Gloucester. Sitting for the Year 1879

Whereas a certain Petition signed by a portion of the citizens of West Liberty School District in Brady township, was presented to the Hon. Court at the November Term praying for a remedy, or at least an alteration of the new township line, in the late division of Brady township; in such a manner as to leave said District as well as many other citizens in the old township. And we understand that the said Petitioners assert among other things, that the said West Liberty School District are unanimous in favor of being left in the old township of Brady.

Now we the undersigned Citizens of that portion of Brady township to be included in the new township according to the late Survey of your commission and the Citizens constituting the West Liberty School Dist in particular would respectfully represent to the Hon. Court, that the said School Dist are not "unanimous" in favor of remaining in the old township, but a very large portion of said Citizens are in favor of taking their chances in the new township, as will be seen by reference to the names herewith annexed. That we have reason to believe and do believe that the said petition was sent to the Hon. Court for the purpose of Delay and perhaps for the final defeat of the new township Organization. And

against any action being taken touching the allegations
of those clams, or any of them made by the said Com-
missioners. and we sincerely hope that the Hon.
Court will allow no impediments to be thrown in
the way of our Speedy Organization,
