ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 26th day of Sept, A. D. 1879, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Bloom, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from at or near Isaac Thomas to Peter Shugerts in Bloom Township

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had, of the premises, do order and appoint S. J. McCloskey, Lewis Wood, J. J. Stull, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.

We the Undersigned Viewers appointed by
the within order of Court, to view and vacate the
Road leading from Henry Augast to the Turnpike
in Bloom Township Respectfully Report.

That having given notice of the time, and place
of meeting, according to the act of Assembly. And being
all present at the view of the road proposed to be
vacated. And having all been sworn, or affirmed, in
pursuance of the said Order. We have viewed the said
Road. And find that in our opinion the said Road is
necessary, for the use of the Public, for the purpose of
getting their stock to water, as well as for other pur-
poses. The road is not more than fifty or sixty perches
in length, and is already opened as far as will be neces-
sary, for the purposes above described. And will not nec-
essarily be any expence to the Township, And we
Therefore refuse to vacate, said road,
