To The Hon Judges of the Court of Clearfield Co
We the undersigned persons appointed by the
Within Order, to view and lay out the Road therein
mentioned, Respectfully report.

That having given notice of the time and place
of meeting according to the act of assembly, and being
all present at the view of the ground proposed for
the said road, and being all sworn or affirmed
in pursuance of the said Order, we have viewed,
and laid out, and do return the following Road
viz. Beginning at the marked Hemlock stump in
land of Silas Woods, at the end of the Township road, near
Henry Bickle's house, and run through land of Woods, and
Bickle north thirty four and a half degrees East, twelve per-
ches to a Post. Thence north four and a half degrees West
twenty nine perches to a Post. Thence through land of Bickle
north forty six degrees East at seven and five tenths per-
ches cross the line of Bickle into Lewis & Weber's land
forty two perches to a Post. Thence through land of Weber
north four degrees East forty two perches to a Post. Thence
north twenty five degrees West thirty eight perches to a
Birch, Thence south one degree West fourteen perches to
a Hemlock, Thence north fifty four and a half degrees East
fifty eight perches to a Post, Thence north eight and a half
degrees West nine perches to a Beech, Thence north fifty six degrees
West (S. 56° W) at three perches crossing the line of Weber
and Robert Thompson, twenty six perches. Thence north
nine degrees East, forty three and five tenths perches to
a marked white pine stump in Thompson's field Thence still

Through Thompson's Land North Eighty Three degrees
East. Twelve perches to a Post. Thence North fifty six
and a half degrees East. nine perches to a Post. Thence
a corner of Robert Thompson and St. Place. Thence
on the line between them North forty five
degrees East. nineteen and two tenths perches to a Post
by the Iron spike. Which said road as aforesaid
laid out, we are of opinion is necessary for public
use. A plan or draft whereof is herewith annexed.

And no damage is claimed by any parties present
through whose land the road passes.

ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 26th day of Sept. A. D. 1879, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Blom*, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from the Erie Turnpike at or near *He Places* to the public Road leading from *Henry Beckles* to the ridge road in *Blom Township*

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint *S. J. McCluskey* *Lewis Wood* *John S. Stute*, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.
