laid out, within one year next preceeding
the presentation of this petition, by which said
opening of the said public road your petitioner
has sustained damage. Your petitioner there-
fore prays your Honors to appoint a jury of
six disinterested persons to view the premises, and
assess the damages sustained by him in con-
sequence of the opening of said public road,
agreeably to the Acts of Assembly in such case
made and provided; and he will pray, &c.

We the undersigned, appointed by the annexed
order of Court, to view the premises, and assess
the damages, if any, which the within petitioner
has sustained by reason of the said road, in
said order mentioned, respectfully report; That
we met for the purpose of performing the duties
imposed upon us by the said order, at the plan-
ing mill of S. I. Henderson on the Thirtieth day
of December, A.D. 1879, and after having been
severally sworn or affirmed, according to law,
proceeded to view the premises and assess the
damages sustained by the petitioner by reason
of the said road passing through his land,
as well as also the ~~advantages~~ advantages to be derived
from such passage, and the probability of the
land reverting to the said petitioner, we are of
opinion that he has sustained damage to the
amount of One hundred and twenty five dollars,
and we do, accordingly, assess the same at that
sum.
