At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 4th day of October A. D.

1889, before Judges of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhabitants of the Township of Jordan in said county, setting forth, that John Klinger

et al asking Viewers to view and vacate
road leading from Josephus to intersect a
road leading from Puzosville to Glen Hope
and known as the McCarthy ridge road

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law,

whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Samuel Wager John Mathew John L. Patterson who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ^{the vacated as also the grounds proposed} grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, ^{and for the vacation of the road as petitioned for} they shall proceed to lay out the same agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do least injury to private property, and state particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose lands said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, ^{and shall also make a like report with draft of that part to be vacated} if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated lands through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th rule of Court.

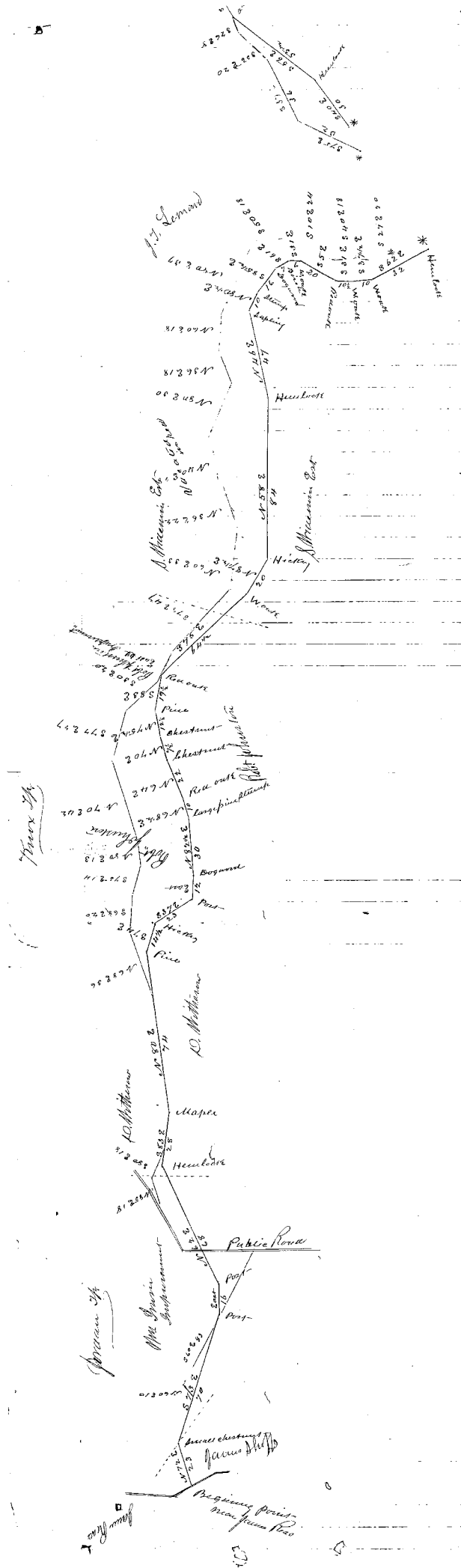
NOTE.—In case of a Private Road, the release must be executed in favor of the petitioner for said road.
Also— Viewers will carefully note the number of days employed and set the amount out at the foot of their return.
Reviewers cannot interfere with damages assessed by the original viewers, except so far as the location may be changed by the reviewers.
N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.

And now 20th July 1880 I do hereby ordered that the proceedings had in the within order ~~to view vacate and supply~~, be referred back to the viewers and it is further ordered that the Pltiff shall so amend the within order, as to make it conform to the requirements of an order to view, vacate and supply, and the viewers are directed to set out in their report, whether or not they vacate any part of said road, known as the "Marlney Ridge Road" as prayed for in the original petition.
