To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace now holding a Court of General Sessions January Term 1879.

The undersigned Commissioners duly appointed by your Honors to divide the township of Woodward in said county, and lay out a new township in and by virtue of the order of Court hereto annexed, Respectfully Report:

That having all first duly sworn to perform the duties of their appointment with fidelity, two of the Commissioners went upon the ground and commenced at the South west corner of Deater township, thence East between tracts in names of William & Henry Drinker seventy two perches to a corner, and corner of new township, thence South between lands of P. Glynn & Thomas Hardison one hundred and forty six perches to a stone pile on line of Thomas Barton tract, thence West on line of tracts in names of Thomas Barton & William Drinker seventy two perches to Maple Creek gone, and corner of tract in name of Thomas Maston, thence South between tracts in names of Thomas Maston & Thomas Barton 236 perches to a Post, then West between Thomas Maston and Matthias Barton tracts 20 perches to a Post, thence South between Matthias Barton & Samuel Hagerty tracts, 236 perches, same course between Israel Wheeler & Saml. Hagerty tracts 240 perches to White Oak, same course between Benjamin Johnson & William Sheff tracts 200 perches to Red oak down, thence East between tracts in name of W^m Sheff and John M. Jordan 28 per to P^o by old waterway, thence between tracts in name of John McCalan and John M. Jordan South 50° West 110 perches to Large White Pine, corner of Lamsbach Benja Wilson & John McCalan tracts, thence South 40° East between tracts in names of Benja Wilson & John McCalan 236 per to Hemlock cor, then South 50° West 14 per to corner of Carl land, and South 40° East by Carl's land one hundred and twenty eight perches to a White Oak - thence North 50° East 14 perches to old line, & thence between George Baker & Pigot Shaw 112 per to White Oak, thence same course between Timothy Pappas & Joseph Ashbridge 116 per to White Pine cor, same course between tracts in name of John Moyer and Thomas Burge, Two hundred and thirty six perches to a Black Oak, thence same course between tracts in names of M^{rs} Gray and Thomas Grant, One hundred perches to Mushannon

100 rods east of the Southwest corner of the
Henry Drinker Survey thence South through
the William Drinker Survey to its South
line thence by said South line 100 rods
West to its Southwest corner and thence
South by the West line of Thomas Barton,
Mathias Barton Loyal Whalan William
Shoff and Thomas P. Wharton Survey to
the line of Gulick Township so that all
that part of the Township lying West of
said line shall constitute the Township of
Woodward and all that part thereof lying
East of said line shall be formed into a
