ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 17th day of January A. D. 1880, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Covington, in said county, ~~setting forth that they labor under great inconveniences for the want of a road or highway leading from~~ asking Viewers to View Vacate & Supply road in Covington, at a point at or near David Askey's place and ending at a point at or near Fair Mount School house

And therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Thos W Moore A. B. Shaw Ans D. W. Moore, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said ~~road~~ ^{"Vacation & Supplying"}; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such ~~road~~ ^{"Vacation & Supplying"}, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.

To the Honorable the Judges within named
We the undersigned Viewers appointed
by the annexed Order of Court, Do Report, that
in pursuance thereof, after having been severally
duly Sworn and Affirmed, all the Viewers appointed
by said Order, viewed the ground proposed for
the within mentioned road and all do agree
that there is occasion for a change in the
location of a portion of said road as de-
sired by the petitioners, inasmuch as great
Damage has been done to the property of
Francis Gennie by reason of said road having
been laid out through his land, which is in
our opinion a great outrage on the rights
of said Francis Gennie. We have there-
fore changed that portion of said road
by vacating the same beginning at the South
East corner of Francis Gennie's land, thence
through the same North 60° degrees West 78-
Rods to his Barn, thence same course 36 Rods
to Big Basin road near Fair Mount School
House, and have supplied the same by
the following road. Beginning at the South
East corner of land of said Francis Gennie
and thence by his line and land of J. B. Reno
North 80 Perches to corner of said Reno & Gennie
on line of Charles Gennet, thence by said Gennet's
land and line of Francis Gennie and Alexander
Veed West 90 perches more or less to inter-
sect the Big Basin road at Fair Mount
