lay out the same. And we will employ



At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of July A. D. 1880, before Judges of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhabitants of the Township of Lawrence in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a public Road or highway leading from Nichols Street in West Clearfield in said Township at its intersection with Front Street to Park Street at its intersection with Public Road in said Township

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law, and make Report to the Court whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint John D Cuttle D W Moore S J Bunge who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road; they shall proceed to lay out the same agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do least injury to private property, and state particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose lands said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated lands through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th rule of Court.

## RELEASE OF DAMAGES.

NOTE.—In case of a Private Road, the release must be executed in favor of the petitioner for said road.

Also— Viewers will carefully note the number of days employed and set the amount out at the foot of their return.

Reviewers cannot interfere with damages assessed by the original viewers, except so far as the location may be changed by the reviewers.

N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.

and lay out a road in "West Clearfield" Respectfully Report

That having first given due, timely & legarotice  
of the time, and place of the meeting of the viewers for more than five  
days previous to making the view, and having been first duly sworn and  
affirmed, they all met upon the ground and proceeded to view and lay  
out, and now return for Public use the following courses & distances  
~~Beginning at the edge of Susquehanna Street, thence along Front Street~~  
1800 feet to Merrell Street, ~~South 3° East~~ <sup>both 3° East</sup> thence by Merrell  
Street, South 87 W. Seventeen hundred eighty two feet, to Park Street  
and by Park Street South 3° West 167 feet to old Township Road, a plot or  
lot of which is here occupied. And they further state that the whole  
route of said road is laid upon streets regularly laid out by the proprietors  
of West Clearfield and for several years have been used and occupied as  
they have been dedicated to Public use, and this view has been made for  
the purpose of compelling the township offices to work upon said streets  
as houses are being built or are now built and necessary improvements are  
required for the proper enjoyment of the road & streets. We find no damages
