2026 PRIMARY/GENERAL ELECTION YEAR CALENDAR - IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

First day to circulate and file nomination petitions February 17
Last day to circulate and file nomination petitions March 10

First legal day to circulate and FILE nomination papers March 11
Last day to file objections to nomination petitions..... March 17

Last day for withdrawal by candidates who filed nomination petitions to withdraw March 25

Last day to register to Vote/Make Changes before the primary election.....May 4

Last day to apply for a civilian absentee /mail-in ballot* May 12

Last day to return voted civilian absentee/mail-in ballots to County Election Office
(Ballots must be received in office by 8:00 pm)..... May 19

GENERAL PRIMARY ELECTION..... May 19

First day to REGISTER after the primary election May 20

Last day to receive voted military and overseas absentee ballots
(Submitted for delivery no later than 11:59 P.M. on May 18) **May 26**

Last day to circulate and FILE nomination papers.....August 3

Last day to file objections to nomination petitions.....August 10

Last day for withdrawal by candidates nominated by nomination papers August 10

Last day for withdrawal by candidates nominated at the primary August 10

Last day to Register to Vote or make changes to a registration..... October 19

Last day to apply for a civilian absentee/mail-in ballots* October 27

Last day to receive voted absentee/mail-in ballots to County Election Office
(Ballots must be received in office by 8:00 pm)..... November 3

GENERAL ELECTION..... NOVEMBER 3

First day to REGISTER after the November election..... November 4

Last day for County Board of Elections to receive voted military and overseas absentee ballots
(Submitted for delivery no later than 11:59 PM on November 2) November 10

* County Election Office open until 5:00PM on this day
