First day to circulate and file nomination petitions	February 17

Last day for withdrawal by candidates who filed nomination petitions to withdraw	March 25
Last day to register to Vote/Make Changes before the primary election.....	May 4
Last day to apply for a civilian absentee /mail-in ballot*	May 12
Last day to return voted civilian absentee/mail-in ballots to County Election Office (Ballots must be received in office by 8:00 pm)	May 19
